The low front, the sweeping windscreen, the bold cut of the tailgate, the large rear window, the thoughtfully planned interior. Just by looking at the Volvo 480, you know it is destined to be another classic Volvo. You also get the distinct feeling that it promises a great deal in terms of performance. And, as you soon discover, both the automatic and manual versions keep those promises handsomely.

The 480 offers a choice of two highly potent engines; a naturally aspirated 2.0 litre version that delivers remarkable fuel economy, and a 1.7 litre turbocharged version. The turbo version is especially responsive; it can accelerate from 0 to 62 mph in just 9.1 seconds, with a comfortable top speed of 125 mph.

But, of course, this standard of performance has not been achieved by sacrificing any of the safety standards which are Volvo hallmarks.

The directional stability is extraordinarily solid for such a low slung car. The rear suspension system keeps the wheel angles and track constant - with no unpredictable steering effects. The ES and turbo versions also feature ABS anti-lock brakes, while the turbo version has the added advantage of TRACS, a traction control system that helps you start smoothly on even the trickiest surface.

And unlike many other cars with an accent on performance, the 480 keeps the driver and passengers supremely comfortable too. It has an ergonomically designed driver's seat with height adjustment and lumbar support, contoured passenger seats with head restraints, and an exceptionally readable control panel. The ES and turbo versions even feature an electronic information centre to keep you fully informed.
