Ford Club Wagons are designed to bring your entire group together in spacious comfort. Versatile Club Wagons can easily seat as many as 12 adults. Or, with seating for five, Club Wagons have enough room left over for twice the gear that conventional wagons can carry. Ford Club Wagons are offered in two wheelbases, 1051/2-in. for 5- and 8-passenger seating and 1231/2-in. for 5, 8 and 12 passengers. Special camper conversions—with single or dual rears—are also available (see pages 6 & 7). And Club Wagon versatility is matched by the ability to handle people and luggage loads of up to 3310 pounds (over $1\frac{1}{2}$ tons).

Power ranges from the standard Ford 240 Six to the optional 300 Six (with California emission package) and 302 V-8.

For all its interior roominess and capacity, a Ford Club Wagon is nimble and easy to handle. Short overall length (shorter than regular wagons) makes parking and maneuvering in tight quarters easy. Ford's famous Twin-I-Beam independent front suspension smooths the ride, and wide-track design provides exceptional highway stability, even in gusty winds. It's a great family wagon for mom and all the kids.

Big Center-Guide sliding side door opens and closes easily with one-hand operation. Door shuts solid and tight. Conventional hinged doors are available. Available, too, is a wide selection of comfort and convenience options including air conditioning, power steering and Cruise-O-Matic transmission. 



You can choose comfortable seating arrangements for 5, 8 or 12 passengers with the capacity to carry people and luggage loads of up to 3310 pounds. The rear seats of any Ford Club Wagon can be removed with hand tools—leaving even more loadspace. Your wide choice of "room plans" is only the beginning. You can select from three distinct levels of luxury: the standard Club Wagon, Custom Club Wagon (interiors shown at left), or top-of-the-line Chateau Club Wagon (pages 2 & 3).

Center-Guide sliding side door. Ford Club Wagons have a large, smooth gliding side door for convenient entry. Requires only one-hand operation. A weather-protected inside step permits easy, low-step entry. Door shuts solid and tight. Center-Guide design provides a unique three-point system that guides and supports on three separate tracks. Conventional hinged double doors with retracting step are available.




5-passenger 105.5-in, wheelbase


5-passenger 123.5-in. wheelbase

Ford Club Wagons and Econoline Vans provide a sound, sensible foundation for your carefree camping enjoyment. They give a great combination of short overall length and handling ease with all kinds of roomy interior arrangement possibilities. Ford Econoline Camper Specials are available with dual-rear wheels for sure stability with big chassis-mounted camper bodies. And the Camper Special chassis-cab (floor and front-end section only) allows the convenient, low-cost installation of the camper body of your choice. You can have full living quarters for up to six with a variety of "summer cottage" interiors.

The Ford Econoline Camper Special (shown at right with typical 19-ft. cab-over chassis-mounted camper) is a sturdy foundation with most of the important chassis components for today's camper service built right in. Standard features include: 302-cu. in. V-8 engine • Select-Shift Cruise-O-Matic transmission • power steering • power brakes • 23-gal. fuel tank (20.3 with evaporative control system) • 70 amp-hr battery • heavy-duty shock absorbers • four 8.00 x 16.5 F (six 8.00 x 16.5D are available for dual rears only) truck-type tires • heavy-duty components for 8300-lb. A compact factory-installed, instrument-panel-mounted front air conditioner is available to cool the driver and front passenger area only, as is desired with some campers.




