







Luggage compartment is exceptionally spacious, weatherproofed, and fully lined. Side mounted spare wheel is readily accessible.

Notice the exceptionally generous width of Monarch's front and rear seats.


There's welcome head and leg room, too. And Monarch's rear seat is well ahead of the rear axle to assure better riding comfort.





#### S P E C I F I C A T I O N S



Engine: 8-cylinder, V-type, L-Head, develops 112 Hp. at 3600 r.p.m. Maximum torque: 206 ft.-lb. at 2000 r.p.m. Taxable Hp. 32.5. Bore, 3-3/16 in.; stroke 4 in. Four degree, three-point rubber mounting. Compression ratio 6.8 to 1.

Lubrication: Gear-type oil pump. Force feed to crankshaft, camshaft, and connecting rod bearings. Replaceable cartridge-type Full-Flow oil filter (optional at extra cost). Positive crankcase ventilation to reduce moisture condensation. Oil capacity, 7 pints; 11 pints when oil filter cartridge changed.

Cooling System: Full-flow system circulates all coolant all the way through block and cylinder heads, for uniform cooling and longer engine life. Two sealed, pre-lubricated double-row ball bearing water pumps. Full length water jacket warms oil in cold weather—cools oil on long drives. Three blade silent fan. Coolant capacity, 19 quarts; 20.2 quarts when fresh-air heating unit installed.

Fuel System: Fuel tank capacity, 15½ gal. Camshaft driven diaphragm-type fuel and vacuum booster pump. Automatic choke. Oil-bath air cleaner. Concentric bowl, dual-downdraft carburetor with "Econ-O-Miser" Valve control.

**Electrical System:** Battery, 17 plate, 100-ampere hour. High-capacity generator with automatic voltage control. Pressure-type automatic spark control. Single-breaker point distributor.

Frame: Heavy steel, cold-riveted and welded. X-member frame with K-type reinforcement bracing. Wheelbase, 118 inches. Overall length, with front and rear bumpers, 207 inches.

**Body:** Heavily reinforced, welded all-steel. Weather sealed and sound conditioned throughout. Fiberglas insulation in top and engine compartment wall.

Wheel Suspension: Front, independent coil springs, with hydraulic telescopic shock absorbers inside. Stabilizer bar to reduce roll. Rear, semi-elliptic leaf springs with full length impregnated liners. Telescopic shock absorbers mounted "sea-leg" fashion to reduce vertical shocks and sidesway.

**Drive:** Single dry-plate clutch with low pedal pressure. Standard 3-speed silent transmission with synchronizers to provide quiet shifting. Hotchkiss rear drive with semi-floating rear axle and hypoid-type ring gear and pinion. Gear ratio 3.9 to 1. Touch-O-Matic Overdrive (optional at extra cost). Axle ratio supplied for overdrive is 4.27 to 1.

Brakes: Hydraulic "Duo-servo" type, giving low pedal pressure. Equalized, cable-type parking brake operates rear wheel brakes only.

**Tires:** Extra low pressure—7.10 x 15 tires with extra-wide rims for safety and riding comfort.

Exterior Colours: Solid enamels—Black, Sheridan Blue, Everglade Green, Sheffield Green, Mission Gray. Metallic enamels: Banning Blue, Luxor Maroon, Culver Blue and Starlight Green. Two tones (at extra cost)—(First colour listed is upper colour): Dune Beige and Penrod Tan; Mission Gray and Sheridan Blue; Sheffield Green and Everglade Green. Special Convertible Colours: Sulphur Yellow and Fez Red.

Upholstery: Closed models: Tan and Gray Stripe Broadcloth with Brown Metallic trim; Blue-Gray Block Broadcloth with Dark Blue Metallic trim; Twotone Green Stripe Broadcloth with Green Metallic. Genuine leather available at extra cost. Convertible: Red and Black all leather with Black trim; Two-tone Tan all leather with Brown Metallic trim; Dark Blue and Ivory all leather with Blue Metallic trim. A choice of Black, or Gray-Tan top with any colour scheme.
