There is no royal road—no magic path—to success.


Success is just another name for service.

All aluminum bodies are expensive. But there's no rumbles, ripples or rust.

It's the body weaving on cold steel that gets on your nerves. The new Jordan bodies are ironed, braced and padded for silence.

In this new fashion car, all instruments are under glass firmly set in rubber. Lighted from without, protected in washing and from rain, they form a concentrated beauty spot—taken in at a glance.

A cowl ventilator keeps the forward compartment cool—operated with a twist of the wrist from the driver's seat.


The shield is rain tight—rare, isn't it?—rubber strips not skimpy—and two flaps enclose the top of the shield.

No top rattling against the windshield. That's an unpleasant worry. A slotted bracket and nut drove that care away.


Tools in a padded and locked compartment in the left front door. No unloading passengers to find a dirty tool roll, usually empty.

Seats lower and tilted more. No hanging on while rounding the corners. Forward vision for occupants of rear seats.


Marshall cushions, deep, luxurious, hold you in your leisurely seat. You can't confuse the new curtain rods. Time, morals, exasperation saved.

Every detail of leather, bindings, carpets, foot pads and hardware the best we can buy.

The new Jordan is a rustless motor car.

Not only the aluminum bodies provide this valuable insurance against deterioration.

Every nickel plated part has a foundation of brass. Steel rusts very quickly when exposed. Every exposed nut, bolt and fitting is rust proofed—then painted.

Clutch and brake pedals stay black. New design accelerator stirrup is of aluminum.

It's the flimsy frames, weaving and twisting that make the body builders trouble. The new Jordan deep frame has tubular torsional resisting cross members. The bodies do not gap at the door openings.

The Jordan velvet spring shackle, the most happy feature on a uniformly quiet car, is improved. Drop forged parts with water and dust proof metal boots.

The motor is the heart of a good automobile.

But the soul of a car finds expression through the spirit of the men who make it. The heart of this remarkable Jordan is a new, distinctive and exclusive motor, of the thoroughly modern, lighter, high speed type.

Engineers have long been baffled in an effort to build a motor that combined silence with what we love to call a "punch." When they built for silence the power was not there.

This Jordan motor has what the small boy would call a "Wallop"—a silent thrilling something that makes the old driver turn and grin. Chain drive is silent. Gears never remain so.


Three point motor suspension reduces strains. A three legged stool never rocks like a four legged table.

Four bearings distribute the load on the crank shaft evenly. Every crank pin has an adjacent main bearing.


Force feed lubrication with a precision instrument constantly before the owner's eye. As long as there is oil there is pressure.

Manifold designed for low grade gas. Many car owners wonder why the Jordan is so economical.


A snappy powerful, high grade, exclusive motor just as accessible as any mechanic wants a good motor to be.

The clutch is of latest design—none smoother or more positive.




A new braking system. Levers cannot jump backward and forward on rough roads.

It is easy to find your place at the curb—easy to handle in crowded traffic.


It has fat wheels—fat cord tires.


