MacPherson strut front suspension system, fade-resisting power-assisted front disc. rear drum brakes, and steelbelted radial tires.

The all new bucket seats (opposite page) fully recline for relaxing and are adjustable so you sit comfortably, but well supported. for short trips or long distance cruising.

Standard Features

Celica's comfortable, yet responsive feel for the road begins with MacPherson strut front suspension system (shown at left); rear stabilizer bar; steel-belted radial tires; and fade resisting power-assisted front disc, rear drum brakes.

Celica has a 2.2 liter 4-cylinder SOHC engine with fully transistorized ignition that's teamed with a 5-speed

overdrive transmission*
Inside, both the GT Sport
Coupe and GT Liftback giv

Coupe and GT Liftback give you an AM/FM/MPX stereo radio. Liftbacks have four speakers. Sport Coupes have

two. And all Celicas have power-assisted Flo-thru ventilation systems. For 1980 the GTs have rectangular quartz

halogen hi-beam headlights for increased long range night vision.


Celica has full instrumentation including an electric tachometer, speedometer with resettable tripmeter,



voltmeter, fuel gauge, oil pressure gauge, coolant temperature gauge and a panel of lights to alert you when the hi-beams are on,

the parking brake is engaged, the fuel level is low or the seat belts are not yet fastened.

All Celicas have rear-window defoggers and day/night nonglare rear view mirrors. Sail-mounted side view mirrors (right) are new this year with the driver's side remote controlled on the GT models.



For added convenience, the windshield wiper/washer and hi-beam/turn signal levers are column mounted. There is also a handy inside hood release and remote control fuel filler door release (GTs).

Options

Both the GT Liftback and GT Sport Coupe can be equipped with aluminum alloy wheels (shown at right). A good looking way to dress up the Celica's styling.

You can take your favorite rock group with you or bring Mozart along with a stereo tape deck (below) in your choice of 8-track or cassette.

If it rains or snows, you'll want a rear washer/wiper to keep the back window



clean and Toyota
makes it available on
the GT Liftback
(shown below).

There's also a rear window shadow kit that helps reduce interior glare.

Another word about the elements. Celica will supply sunshine or moonlight, if you wish, through a sliding sun

roof. Enjoy the sky as you drive your Celica. Your only obligation is to turn the crank.

For people who like the convenience of not shifting



gears, a smooth-shifting 3-speed automatic transmission (left) is available on the GT Liftback and ST Sport Coupe. There's also the option and pleasure of power steering**

Furthermore, Celica will let you select the air

of your choice. Optional air conditioning** lets you change an uncomfortable hot day outside into a cool refreshing day inside. All you have to do is set the controls.
