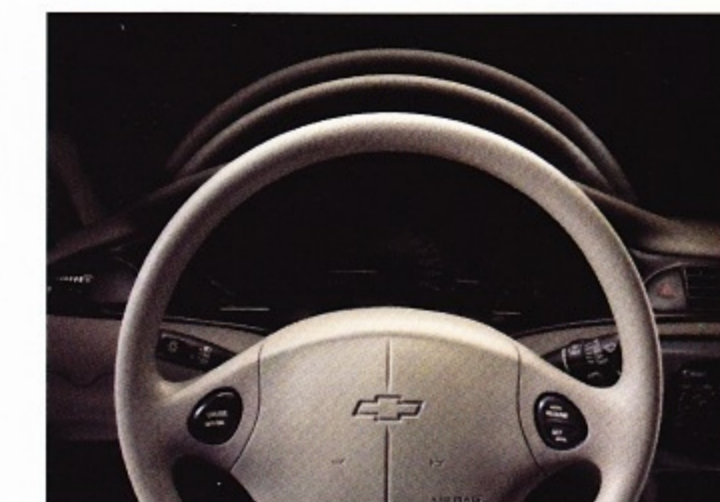

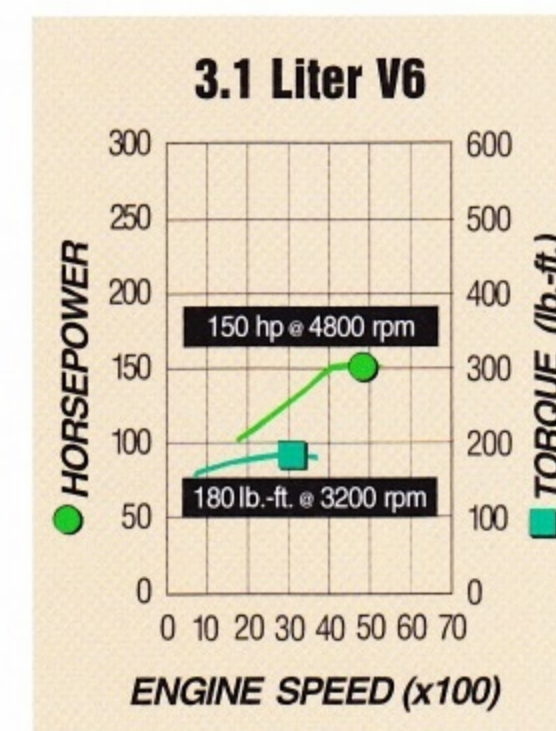
### 3100 V6 with Sequential Fuel Injection

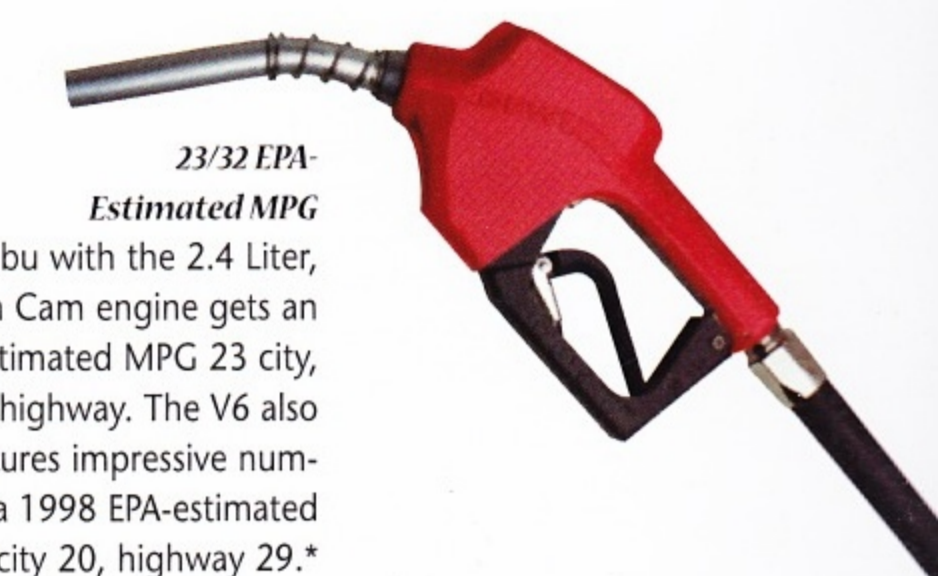
### 2.4 Liter, Twin Cam Engine

## Long-Life Transmission Fluid

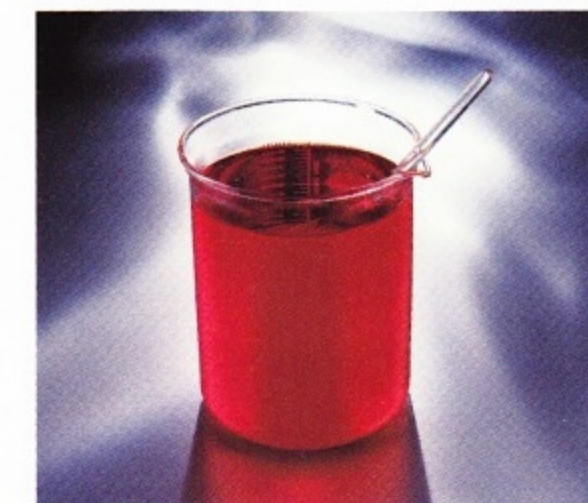

## Galvanized-Steel Body

Malibu body panels are made of two-sided galvanized steel (except the roof), for unsurpassed protection against corrosion. The zinc coating actually helps prevent surface rust on the outside due to minor chips or scratches, and helps prevent holes which could start from the inside.



## Extended-Life Engine Coolant

The engine coolant in Malibu has a scheduled replacement interval of up to five years or 150,000 miles\* (whichever comes first).

## Stainless-Steel Exhaust System

The muffler and tailpipe are made of aluminized stainless steel, for excellent protection against corrosion. In addition, the take down pipe, extension pipe and the catalytic converter shell are made of stainless steel, providing protection for the entire exhaust system.

## Innovative "Rain Gutter"

An integral "roof ditch molding" is designed to help keep you dry when getting in or out of your Malibu on rainy days.

## A Quality Paint Process

The foundation for this quality finish is two-sided galvanized-steel body panels that actually "heal" themselves when scratched. Then, it's into the paint booth for phosphate coating and a rust-fighting primer, topped by a glass-smooth primer surfacer. Finally, the basecoat goes on, followed by a clearcoat, for a durable shine.

## Frame Under-Glass Door Design

This design improves aerodynamics, contributing to reduced wind noise at highway speeds.

A specially designed radio antenna and sculpted mirrors add to a quiet ride.

## Dampening Baffles in Floor, Rockers, Body and Pillars

The extensive and innovative use of advanced acoustic materials is designed to make Malibu a quiet car.

## Front Chassis Frame

The front chassis frame design delivers a very pleasing and responsive driving experience while contributing to occupant safety. It is a robust, structurally rigid design.

## Recessed Windshield Wipers

The windshield wipers on Malibu are positioned well below the airstream, which helps reduce wind noise caused by air turbulence at highway speeds.

## Added Insulation

Engine and road noise is reduced, thanks to a thicker floor board pad and extra dampening material in the floor and rear-window shelf area.

## Liquid-Filled Engine Mounts

The Malibu engine floats on hydraulic mounts. This system actually tunes certain engine noises to levels inaudible to the human ear.

## Aluminum Brake Calipers

All-aluminum front brake calipers with aluminum pistons reduce weight by 20 percent, when compared to conventional systems. Audible wear sensors for the front disc brake pads are standard. Special note: Non-asbestos material is used for both the front pads and rear shoes.

## Noise-Reducing Steering Gear

New-for-'99: The steering gear now has isolated inner tie rods, which results in reduced road noise and vibration being transferred into the passenger compartment.

## No Timing Adjustments — Ever

A direct ignition system eliminates the need for periodic engine timing adjustments.
