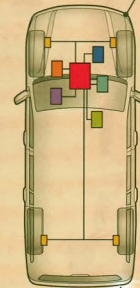

### Vehicle Skid Control System

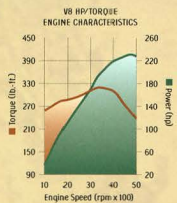
Land Cruiser's Vehicle Skid Control (VSC) system works together with 4-wheel ABS and Active TRAC to help maintain traction. Utilizing an array of sensors and controls spread throughout the vehicle, VSC helps detect the onset of lateral traction loss (understeer and oversteer). If either condition is detected, the VSC control unit sends signals to reduce power and apply braking to the appropriate wheels, thereby assisting the driver in maintaining control of the vehicle.

**Basic Coverage:** All components other than normal wear and maintenance items are covered for 36 months/36,000 miles.  
**Powertrain Coverage:** Your engine, transmission/transaxle, front-wheel drive, rear-wheel drive, seatbelts and air bags are covered for 60 months/60,000 miles.  
**Rust-Through Coverage:** Corrosion perforation of sheet metal is

covered for 60 months/unlimited miles.  
**Federal Emission Coverage:** Components under the federal emission defect warranty are covered for 36 months/36,000 miles and specified major emission control components are covered for 8 years/80,000 miles. Specified major emission control components under emission performance warranty are also covered for 8 years/80,000 miles. In addition, emission performance warranty is applicable for 24 months/24,000 miles in states and local jurisdictions that require a periodic EPA-approved inspection and maintenance program.

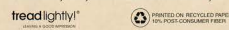
