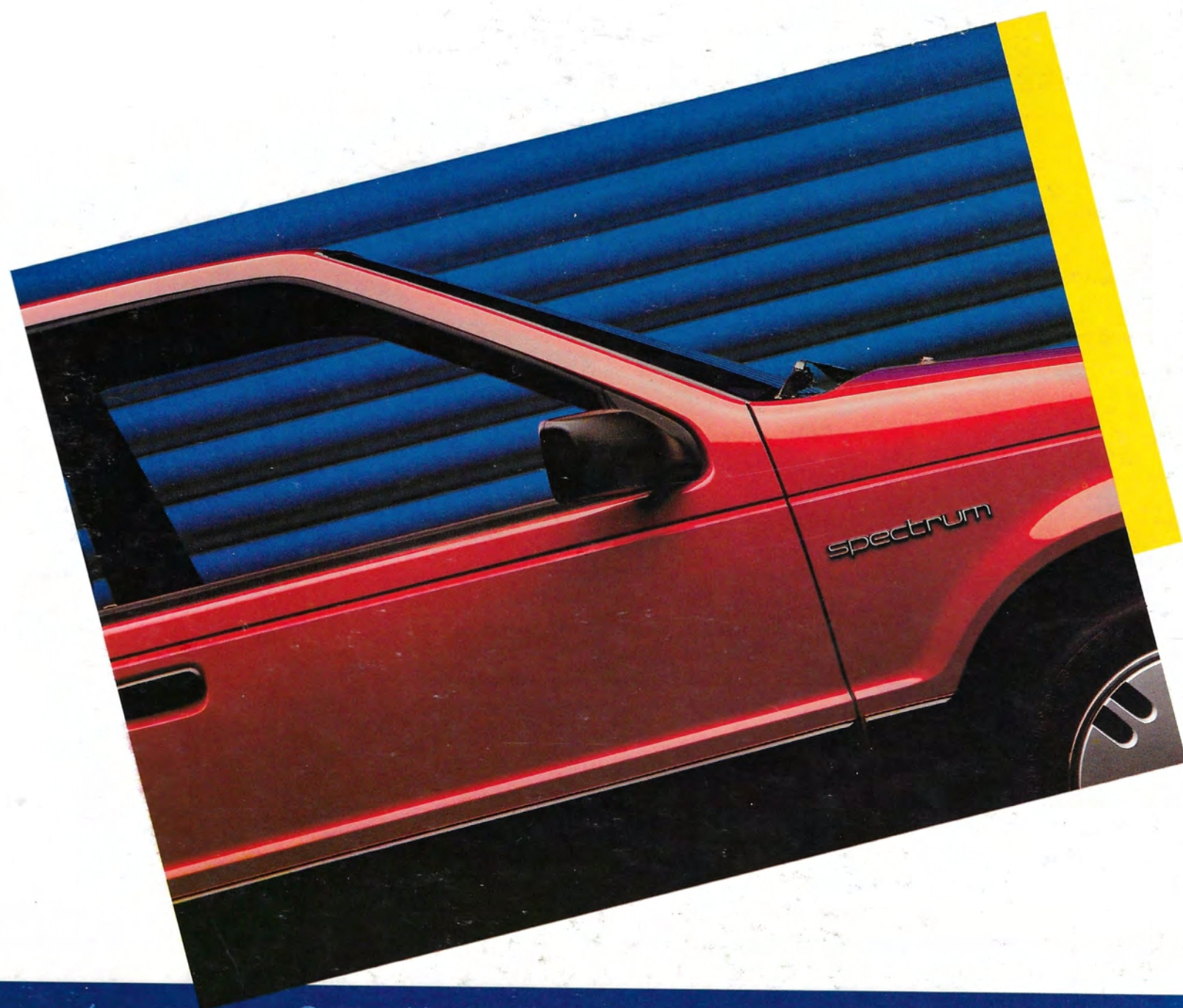
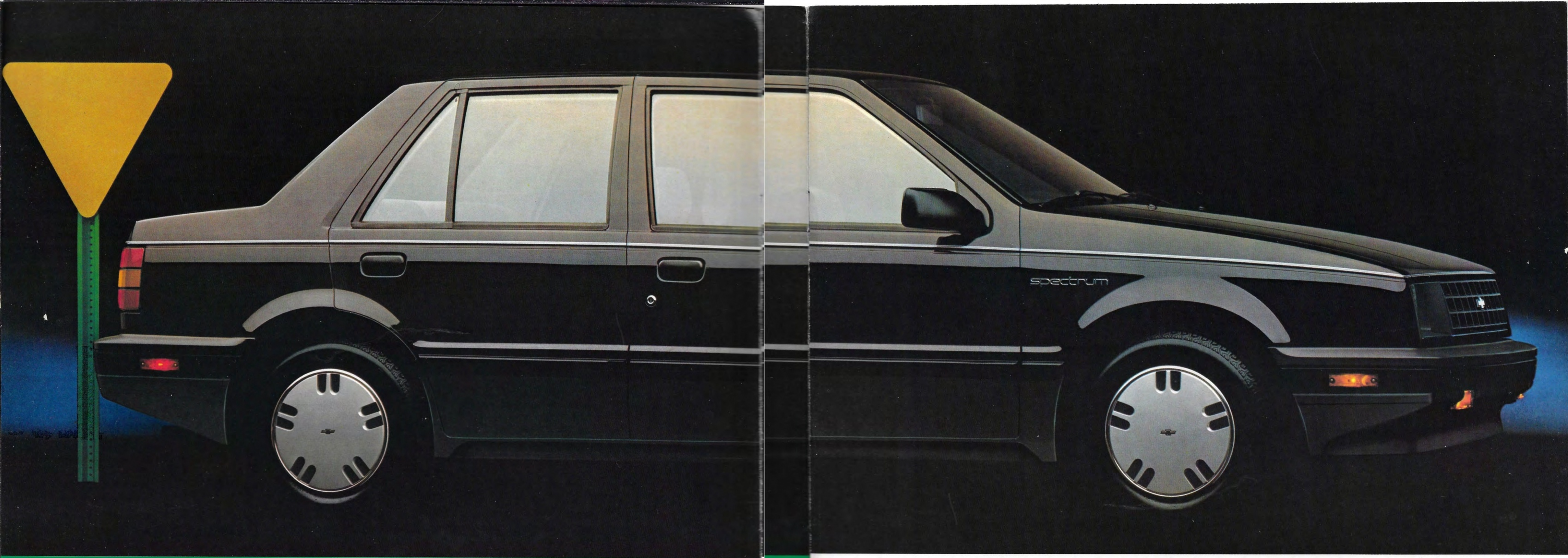

That's just the beginning. As you read these pages, you'll see many of the other details that make Spectrum such a class act.

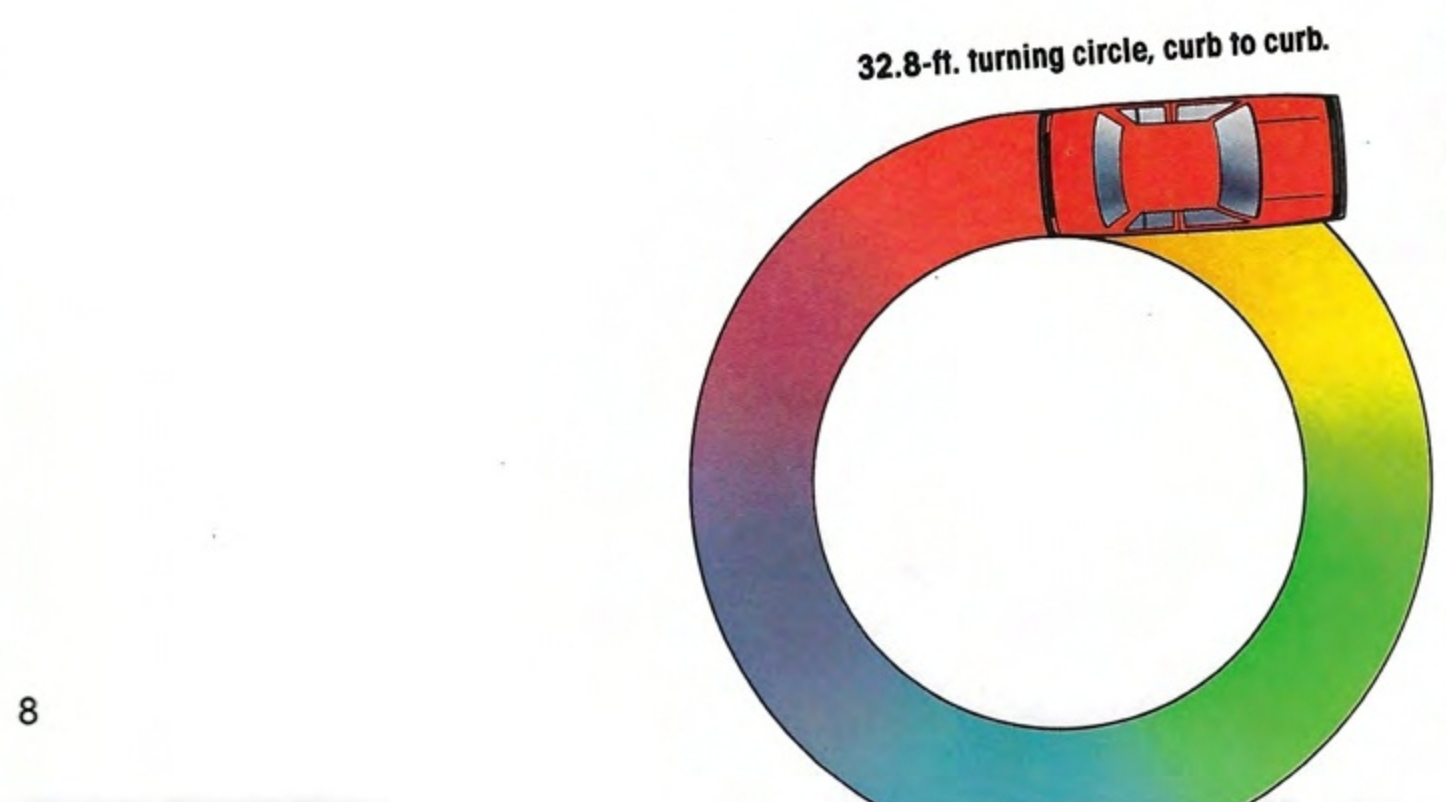

It's a vast and varied world, filled with everything from freeways to forested lanes, mountains to deserts to pothole-pitted city streets.

Spectrum is engineered to meet those real-world challenges, with eagerness and dependability.

To begin with, Spectrum feels solid and substantial. Powered by a high-efficiency 1.5 Liter overhead cam engine, Spectrum eagerly makes tracks through all sorts of terrain. Front drive and MacPherson-strut front suspension contribute to Spectrum's surefootedness and accurate cornering. Stopping is handled by power front disc/rear drum brakes, while standard all-season steel-belted radial tires are designed to handle the rigors of driving on less than perfect roads.

And because it can be tough out there, Spectrum also incorporates extensive corrosion protection. Body panels electroplated with nickel and zinc, primer bonded electrically to metal, chip-resistant Plastisol coating to shield fender and lower body panels—all contribute to Spectrum's ability to fend off the effects of road debris and salt.

No matter what the world has waiting, Spectrum makes driving enjoyable, wherever and whenever you ask it to go.

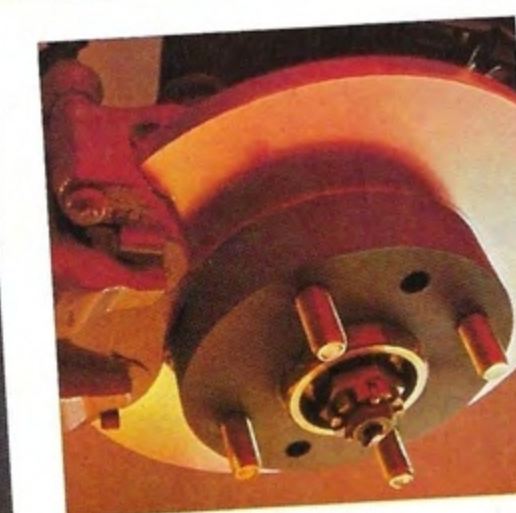

When you open the door of Spectrum Coupe, you'll see a remarkable balance between a sporty driver's coupe and the outright usefulness of up to 29.4 cu. ft. of cargo space, with rear seat-backs folded.

The driver in you will appreciate the way Spectrum seats you before the instrument panel. Most controls are fingertip-convenient, the gages are well positioned and legible, and the available tachometer lets you monitor engine RPM. A smooth-shifting 5-speed manual or available 3-speed automatic transmission responds easily to your command.

Your practical nature will find the big bumper-level hatch/tailgate functional and convenient. The split fold-down rear seats are another good idea—lower one or both as needed and you open up a wide, carpeted area with cargo straps that keep skis, golf clubs or other cargo firmly in place.

Just carrying passengers? There's plenty of room to stretch out, front and rear, in seats built with full foam cushioning. The front seats are fully reclinable while the rear seat-backs feature a three-way rake adjustment to accommodate taller occupants.

Care for a little road music? You have your choice of several GM-Delco music systems, including an available AM/FM electronically tuned radio with seek and scan, cassette, digital clock and dual rear speakers that are strictly state of the art.
