SPECTRUM SEDAN

SEATING COMFORT. Spectrum Sedan's aircraft-style doors open with plenty of headroom into a spacious four-passenger interior. Inside Spectrum Sedan you'll find:

- Contoured reclining front bucket seats with adjustable head restraints.
- Rich all-cloth seat fabrics.
- Head and leg room sufficient to accommodate four adults.

A BIG TRUNK. Yes, you can take it with you.

- Spectrum's large 11.4-cu.-ft. trunk opens at bumper level for easy loading.
- For your convenience, a single key operates all doors, trunk and ignition.
- The load floor is fully carpeted.

HIGH-EFFICIENCY POWER TEAMS. Spectrum's 1.5-liter engine offers the following high-efficiency features:

- A single overhead cam design (SOHC) for increased power output at high RPM. This is a sophisticated design which places the camshaft in the cylinder head. There are fewer moving parts since the overhead cam operates on the valves more directly than in a pushrod engine. That means less inertia, higher engine speeds and more power available when you need it.
- The two-ring piston design helps reduce friction and increase engine efficiency.
- A smooth-shifting 5-speed manual transmission with overdrive on both 4th and 5th gears. A 3-speed automatic is optional.

IMPRESSIVE STANDARD FEATURES.

Spectrum's lengthy list of standard features includes:

- Rack-and-pinion steering.

- Power front disc/rear drum brakes.
- All-season steel-belted radial tires.
- Maintenance-free battery.
- Tinted glass, all windows.

THE ALL-PURPOSE AUTOMOBILE. Spectrum Hatchback can transport people, cargo or both. With rear seat-backs up, it seats four in comfort. Fold one seat-back down to accommodate three people, and their luggage. Or fold both seat-backs down, making up to 29.7 cubic feet of load space available through the 32.2-inch-wide rear hatch. Leave your options open, with Spectrum Hatchback.

- Molded vinyl headliner.

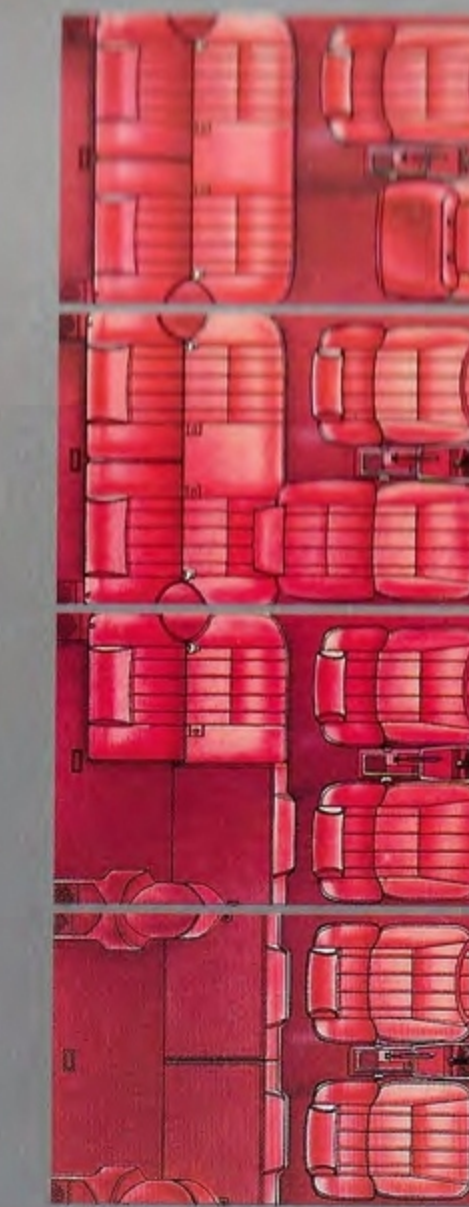

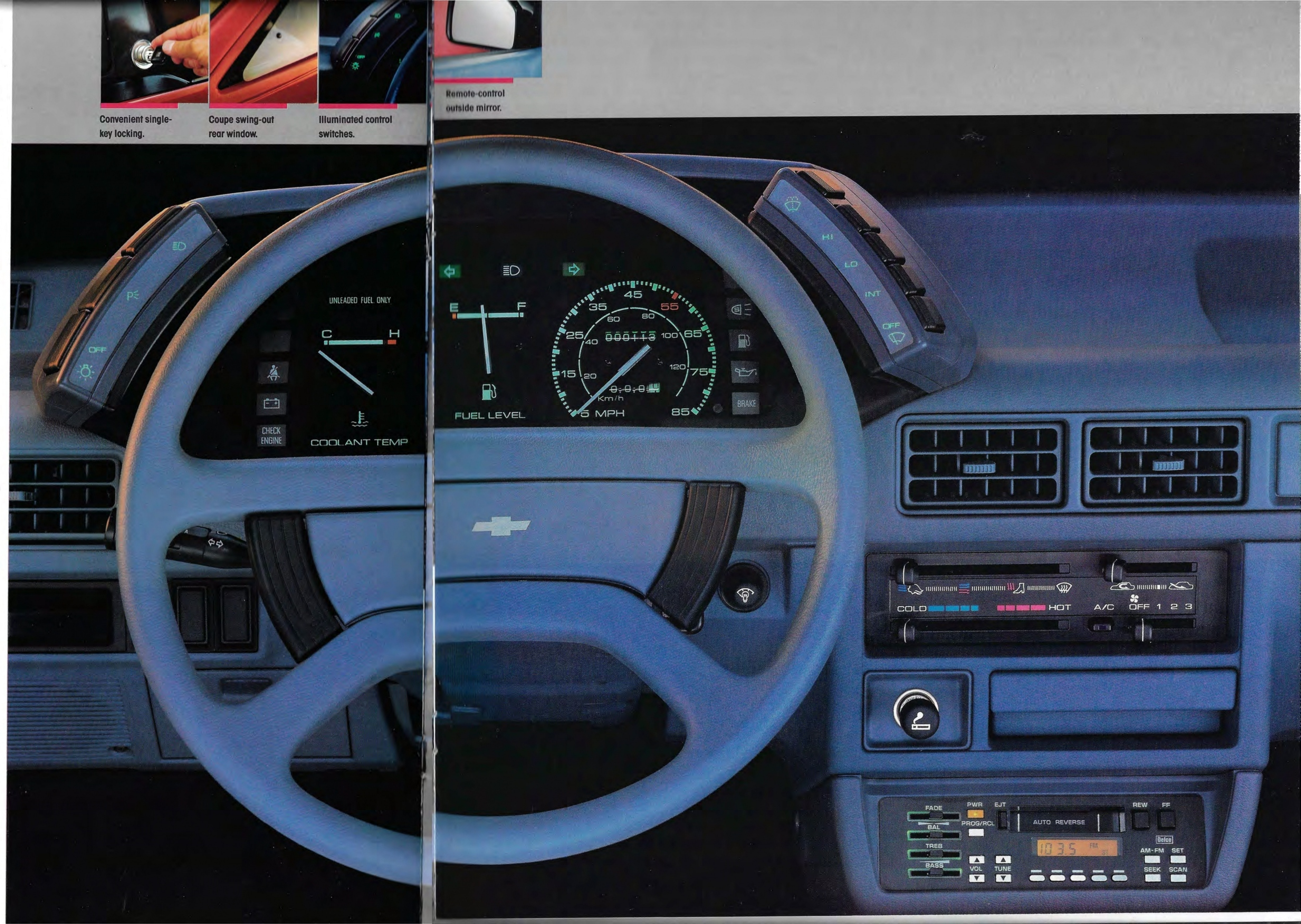

- A dual-barrel carburetor designed to help provide pleasing low- and mid-range throttle response.
- A full-transistor ignition for fast, sure starting and long spark plug life.
- A two-ring piston design that reduces friction and offers

greater operating efficiency. This advanced engine technology is combined with Spectrum's strong but lightweight unitized body construction to provide the often elusive goal of economical operation* and satisfying performance.

ADDED VALUE FEATURES.

- A smooth-shifting 5-speed manual transmission puts the horsepower to the pavement. If you prefer, a 3-speed automatic is optional.
- Front-drive traction and precise rack-and-pinion steering make the driving even more fun, while the stopping is handled by the power front disc/rear drum brakes.

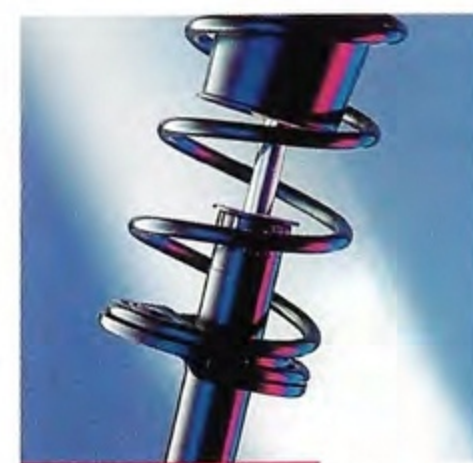

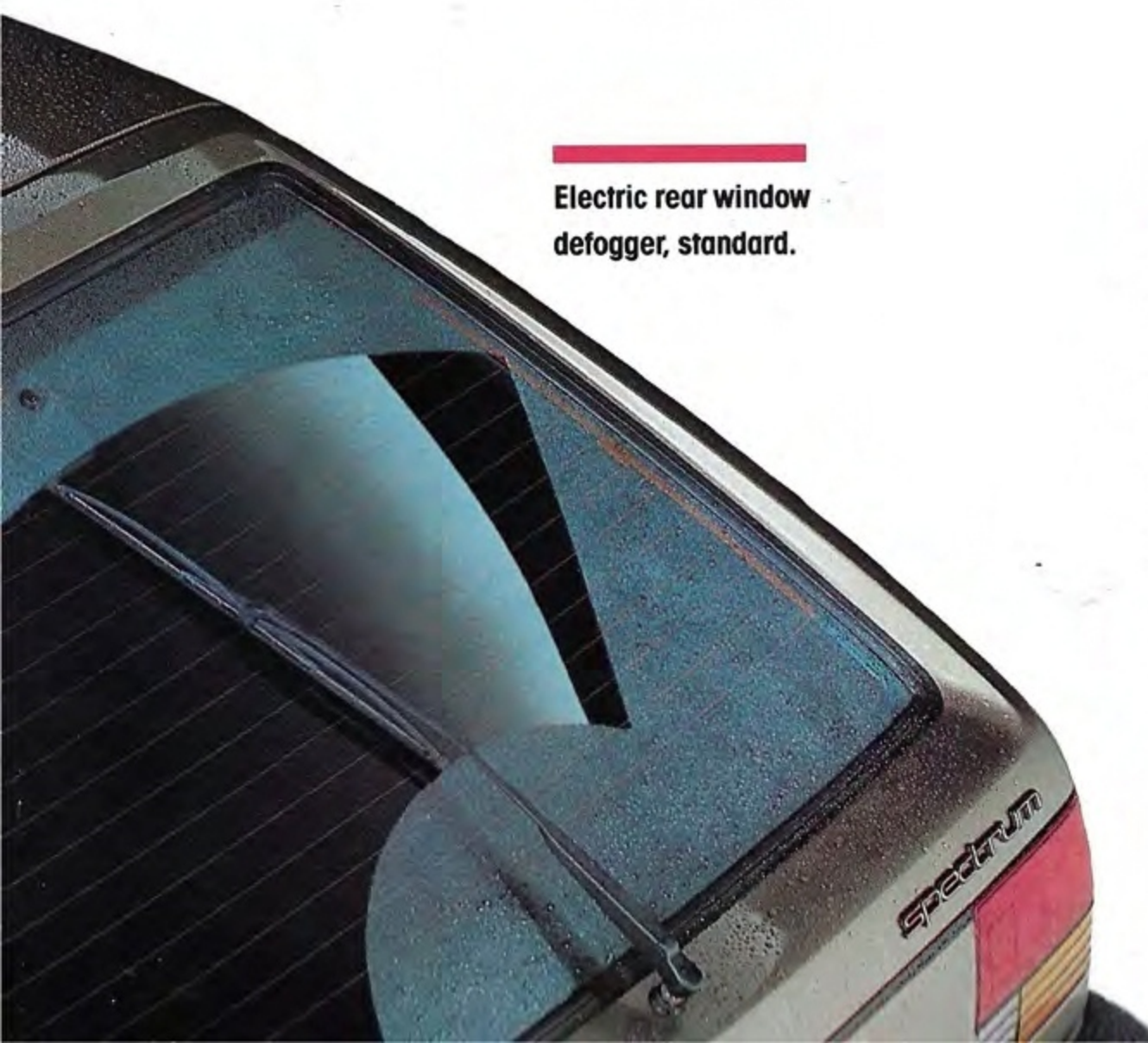
