V8 - A RETURN TO POWER.

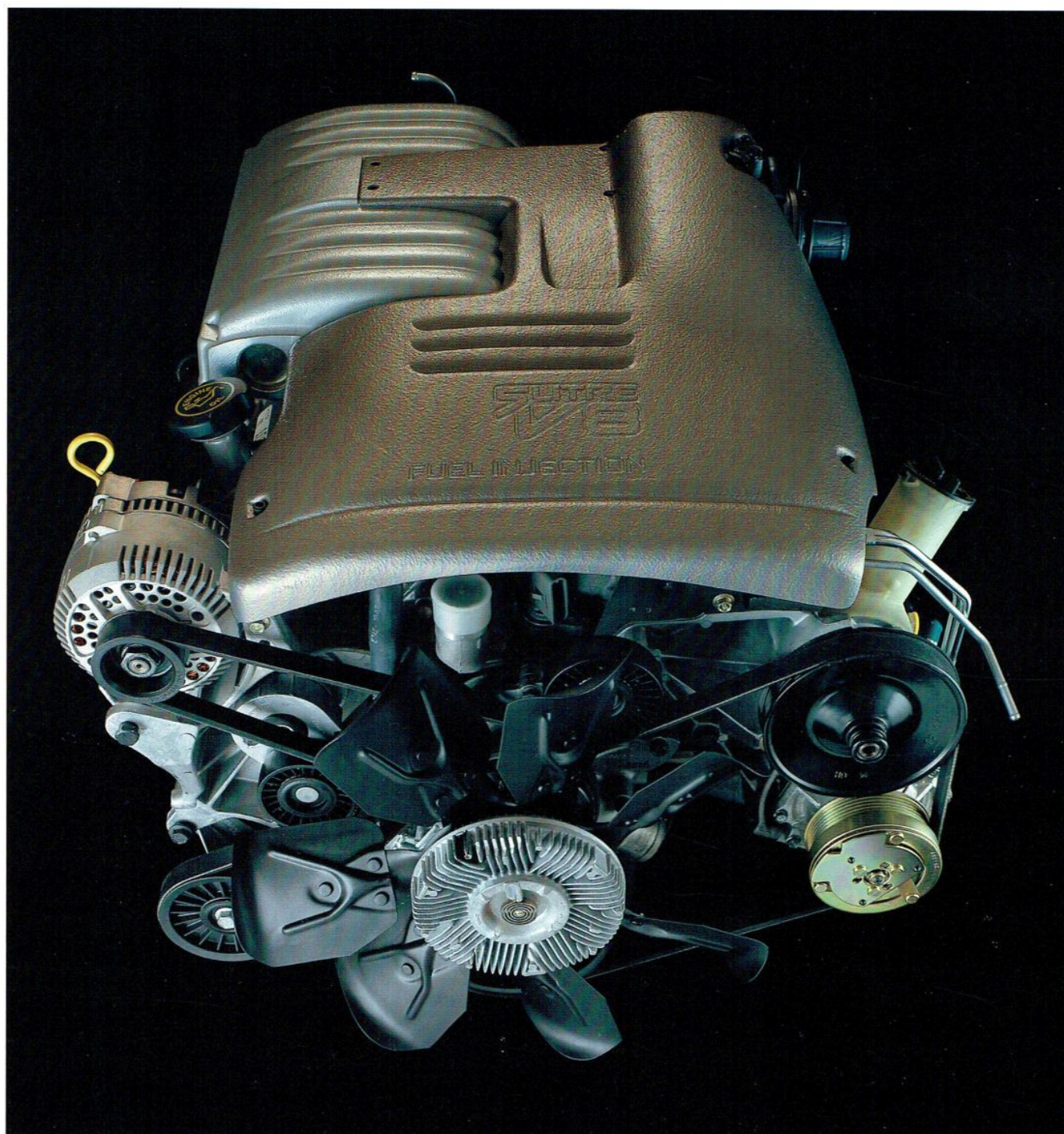
The 5 litre Falcon V8 engine is the inheritor of a proud tradition of Ford V8s. And this engine is a worthy successor to those illustrious predecessors.

Equipped with Sequential Multipoint electronic fuel injection, which is sequenced to engine valve timing to inject fuel at precisely the right moment for optimum efficiency, the Falcon V8 is designed to

develop a stirring 165kW of power at 4500 rpm with tremendous torque figures of 388Nm at 3000 rpm. Yet this engine isn't just about raw power.

It is a product of technical excellence that delivers its copious quantities of energy smoothly and effectively.

To keep your engine operating at peak efficiency, Ford's EEC4 Engine Management System monitors and



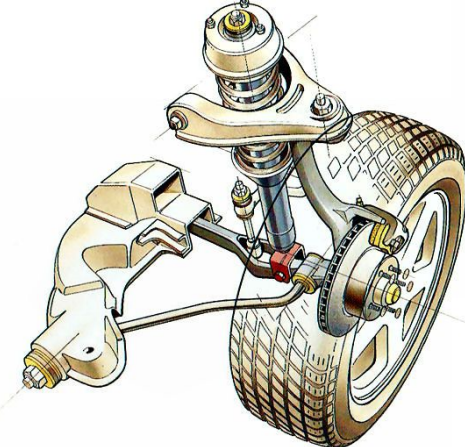
controls sixteen important engine functions, including fuel/air mixture, air intake and coolant temperature, fuel flow and ignition timing.

For efficient breathing, air intakes have been totally redesigned for low restriction. A mass air flow sensor is provided for greater metering accuracy by the Electronic Engine Control Unit.

This modern technology enables the Falcon S XR8 to return 9 litres/100km (31 mpg) on the Australian Standard AS 2877 highway cycle, demonstrating a remarkable combination of power and fuel efficiency.

Efficiency is also the watchword for the exhaust system. A semi-dual design is utilised featuring 63mm (2.5") pipes to reduce back pressure. The system is constructed of long-lasting stainless steel and finishes with the flourish of a chrome plated tailpipe.

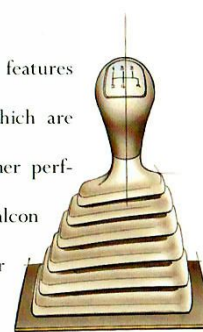
No other engine has the ability to seemingly shorten distances, flatten hills, or make light work of a tow load like a V8. And no other car combines V8 performance with sports handling, plus style and comfort like Falcon S XR8.



YOU CAN HANDLE IT.

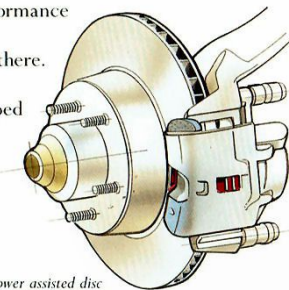
As you'd expect in a car with such high performance characteristics, great attention has been paid to the areas of suspension, steering and brakes.

The latest model 'S' features changes and improvements which are also included in its even higher performance derivative, the new Falcon S XR8. Spring rates and upper and lower rear suspension bushes have been revised, as have shock absorbers which now feature nitrogen gas pressurization. A shorter jounce bump limiter is designed to give better

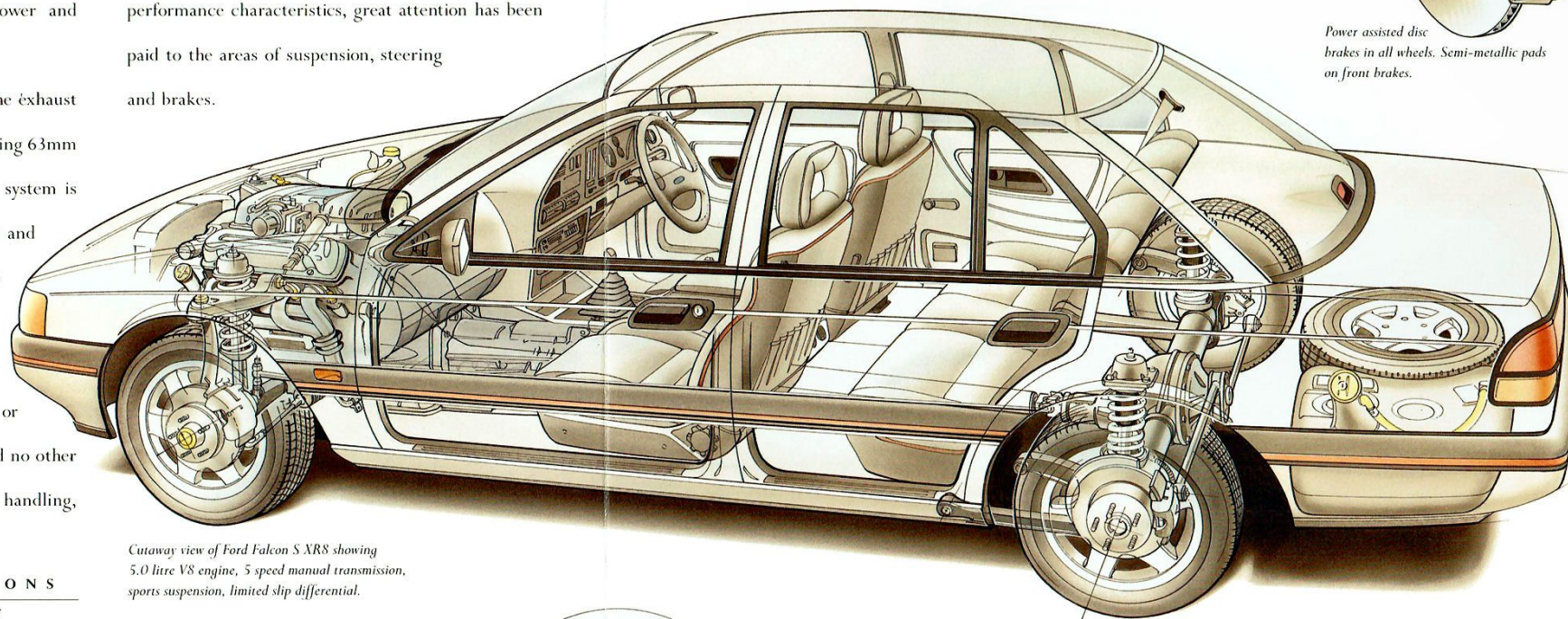


"on-centre" steering ratio has been revised to 18.5 to 1, which means a sharper, quicker-reacting system. And to improve 'feel' there are now solid steering rack mountings. Steering is via a power-assisted rack and pinion.

The list of performance features doesn't stop there. Because on XR8, equipped with 5-speed manual



Power assisted disc brakes in all wheels. Semi-metallic pads on front brakes.

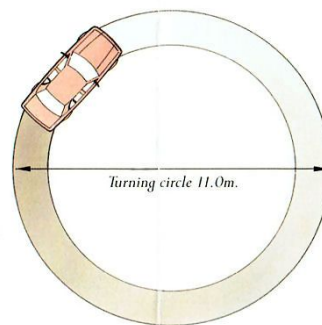


Cutaway view of Ford Falcon S XR8 showing 5.0 litre V8 engine, 5 speed manual transmission, sports suspension, limited slip differential.

At the front, you'll find the advanced SLALS (short and long arm long spindle) suspension system. Rear suspension is via Watts Link in sedans and the trusted 'Hotchkiss' system in the wagon.



ride and directional stability on rough surfaces. Other suspension mount improvements are designed for greater durability and quietness of operation.

For enhanced steering response, the

transmission, you'll also find a traction-enhancing limited slip differential fitted.

To stop the show, there are power-assisted disc brakes on all four wheels, with semi-metallic front pads and dual diaphragm brake booster fitted to XR8.



YOU'RE SITTING COMFORTABLY.

While both Falcon S and XR8 are a rare treat to drive, inside they treat you with uncommon luxury. There's plenty of leg, shoulder and headroom for the driver and up to four adult passengers.

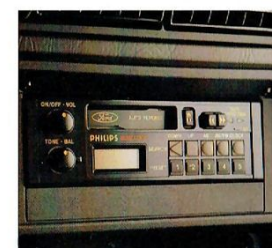
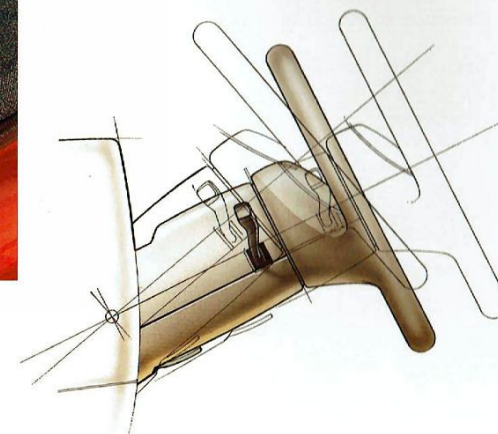
Driver and front seat passenger are comfortably and securely held in bucket seats. In the XR8, these are

deeply sculptured sports seats, stylishly designed, and offering superb lateral support. The seats feature adjustment both fore and aft and backrest recline.

As is appropriate in such a car, the driver receives special attention with adjustable lumbar support, seat height adjustment and a foot rest. Head restraints are also adjustable and of see-through design. The seats are upholstered in co-ordinated fabric trim.

TAKE CONTROL.

As you sit behind the padded wheel of the Falcon S or XR8, all the instrumentation comes readily to the eye whilst controls are close at hand. Twin lever combinations on the steering column control turn indicators and washer/wipers whose functions include demand wash/wipe and an intermittent setting. The steering column itself is adjustable for both height and reach.



Other controls include electrically operated exterior mirrors, power door locks and heater adjustment.

The instrument panel contains an analogue display that quickly and accurately keeps you informed. It features large speed and tachometer dials surrounded by gauges for fuel, oil pressure, engine coolant temperature and battery voltage. In a strip

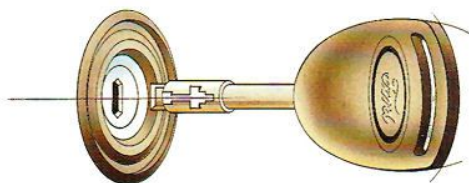
For further refinement on the move, you can enjoy the sounds of a security-coded electronically-tuned AM/FM stereo radio/cassette player with twin speakers, auto reverse and auto memory storage. Or as an extra cost option, you can drive to the sound of Ford's deluxe audio entertainment unit with four speakers, joystick control, digital seek tuning and security coding.

A R E L A X E D A T M O S P H E R E .

No matter how hot it is outside, you'll keep your cool with the factory-fitted air conditioning system that is standard equipment on XR8 and available as an extra cost option on Falcon S.



T H E S E C U R I T Y S T O R Y .

So that Falcon S XR8 and Falcon S attract only admiring looks from persons other than the owner, a number of theft deterrent features are included. Chief among these is the fitting of high security 'Tibbe' locks to doors, ignition, and boot/liftgate. There's security coded audio equipment, recessed door lock buttons to help guard against unauthorised entry and a reinforced ignition lock barrel.



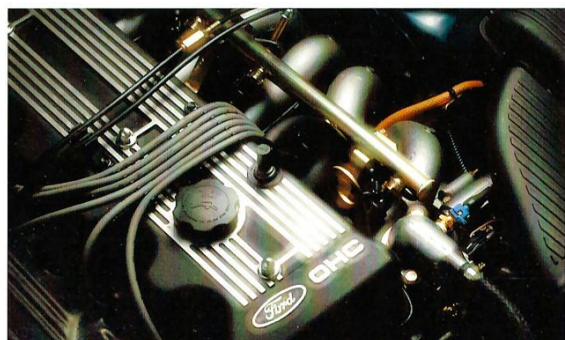

Falcon S and XR8 both put their power to work through a smooth and positive 5-speed manual gearbox. For drivers who prefer an automatic, Falcon's advanced, electronically controlled 4-speed transmission is available as an option at extra cost.

This silky-smooth, Australian made electronic transmission produces outstanding fuel economy with quiet operation.

Fuel saving features include a power/economy switch changeable by the driver to suit driving conditions and a torque converter with 'lock-up clutch'.
