With Holden Satellite Navigation, Turn-By-Turn or Full Colour Mapping, you have total control.

- Turn-By-Turn navigation instructions appear on the centre driver display.
- Full Colour Mapping navigation is displayed on the centre console colour LCD display.
- Both navigation systems are activated by the steering wheel mounted NAV button.
- 4 Full Colour Mapping navigation and menu system can also be activated by the console mounted NAV button.
- Steering wheel mounted thumbwheels control all primary Turn-By-Turn navigation functions.
- 6 Centre console mounted menu dial and soft keys control all primary functions for Full Colour Mapping navigation.





Holden's Satellite Navigation is so easy to use, and so useful, you'll wonder how you ever got anywhere without it.

Using the integrated controls, either on the steering wheel or centre console, you can enter the street address of your destination, call it up from lists of your preset and past destinations, select it from a database of 380,000+ points of interest* – including ATMs, car parks and hotels – or even key in its GPS co-ordinates directly.

Once the system knows where you're going, it rapidly determines your route: the shortest trip, fastest, or an optimal combination of the two, depending upon your preference. The route can also factor in many other considerations – like avoiding tollways, particular roads, or even specific sections of a road.

If you miss a turn, encounter heavy traffic or are required to take an unplanned detour, the system can quickly re-route your journey on command. It couldn't be simpler.

Accompanied, if you wish, by verbal instructions blended with the audio system output, and channelled through your choice of one or more speakers.

Full Colour Mapping navigation^a offers all the features of Turn-By-Turn plus a full colour map with a host of custom settings and an adjustable scale that displays on your vehicle's centre console LCD screen. Your maps can be fixed north or aligned with the direction you're travelling, include icons for as many as 380,000 points of interest, and even zoom in automatically as you approach a decision point. It's up to you.

Either way, the satellite navigation hardware is compact and sits discreetly in your vehicle's glove box, with no obscure attachments impeding your driving space and all wiring hidden from view. And because it utilises the latest Sensis Whereis® In-car Navigation Map Data, you'll be able to obtain updated road and point of interest information regularly.

Turn-By-Turn navigation system

Turn-By-Turn navigation features include:

- Operation via steering wheel mounted controls
- Turn arrow guidance via the centre driver display, including distance bar to indicate distance to next decision point
- Integrated voice guidance via the vehicle's audio system, including variable volume blending with radio, CD or DVD audio output (where fitted)
- Ability to select all speakers, front, front right or front left for output of voice guidance
- Where am I' screen indicating current street name and city/town
- Time travelled, distance to destination, current location and GPS co-ordinates display
- Points of Interest search at current location, destination or full Points of Interest database search



Switch on Turn-By-Turn navigation and it immediately displays your vehicle's current position.




Once a destination is selected and a route activated, Turn-By-Turn navigation displays:

- The next street name if known, or its distance away if not known
- The street your vehicle is in
- A distance bar that graphically represents the distance to your next decision point
- The direction required at the next decision point.

Full Colour Mapping navigation system

In addition to all the Turn-By-Turn system features listed above, Full Colour Mapping navigation offers:

- Operation via steering wheel mounted controls and centre console menu dial and soft keys
- Full colour mapping via the centre console colour display
- Customisable routes to reflect your personal preferences, such as routes with or without tolls, or taking a particular road
- Maps can include icons for up to 14 points of interest categories
- Variable scaling –
 50 metre to 100km resolution
- The ability to store past destinations as memory presets for fast selection and re-use, or to simply select a destination by pointing to it on screen
- Automatic zoom in on approach to next decision point







When initially switched on, the Full Colour Mapping navigation displays your vehicle's current position.

You can choose from a range of display modes, including full screen with travel time and time of arrival, map with direction arrow or map only.

Maps can also be orientated with a fixed north **3** or aligned to the vehicle's direction of travel.
