
Large parking lights blend with the massive grille. The rub rail sweeps the full length of the body for extra beauty and protection.

The rear deck ornament with the handsome Monarch crest sweeps across the deck-lid and conceals the new deck-lid latch with its rich chrome styling.



#### SPECIFICATION HIGHLIGHTS

ENGINE: The 1950 MONARCH 8-cylinder, V-type, L-head engine develops 110 Hp. at 3600 r.p.m. Maximum torque: 200 foot pounds at 2000 r.p.m. Taxable Hp. 32.5. Bore, 3-3/16 in.; stroke, 4 in. Total displacement, 255 cu. in. Three point rubber mounting. Compression ratio, 6.8 to 1.

LUBRICATION: Gear-type oil pump. Force feed to all crankshaft and camshaft bearings. Heavy-duty cartridge-type oil filter optional. Positive crankcase ventilation to reduce moisture condensation. Oil

capacity, 7 pints, 9 pints when oil filter changed.

COOLING SYSTEM: Full-flow system circulates all coolant all the way through block and cylinder heads, for uniform cooling and longer engine life. Two sealed, pre-lubricated double row ball bearing water pumps. Full length water jacket warms oil in cold weather-cools oil on long drives. New 3-blade silent fan. Coolant capacity, 19 quarts. FUEL SYSTEM: Fuel tank capacity, 151/2 gal. Camshaft driven diaphragm-type fuel and vacuum booster pump. Automatic choke. Oil-bath air cleaner. Concentric bowl, dual-downdraft carburetor, with "Econ-o-miser" valve control.

ELECTRICAL SYSTEM: Battery, 17 plates, 100-ampere hour. Highcapacity generator with automatic voltage control. Automatic spark

control. Single-breaker distributor.

FRAME: Heavy steel, cold-riveted and welded. X-member frame with K-type reinforcement bracing. Wheelbase, 118 inches. Overall length 207 inches; station wagon, 214 inches.

BODY: Heavily reinforced welded all-steel. Insulated top, floor and

side panels against noise and heat.

WHEEL SUSPENSION: Front, independent coil springs, with hydraulic telescopic shock absorbers inside. Stabilizer har to control sidesway. Rear, semi-elliptic leaf springs, with full-length impregnated linersno lubrication required. Telescopic shock absorbers mounted "sea-leg" fashion to reduce vertical shocks and sidesway.

DRIVE: Single, dry plate clutch with low pedal pressure. Standard 3-speed silent transmission with synchronizers to provide quiet shifting. Hotchkiss rear drive with semi-floating rear axle and hypoid-type ring gear and pinion. Integral hub and axle. Wheel bearings permanently lubricated. Gear ratio 3.9 to 1. Axle ratio for overdrive is 4.27 to 1.

TOUCH-O-MATIC OVERDRIVE: Gives you several free miles on every gallon. It's an automatic fourth gear that permits your engine to loaf while your car skims ahead. Engine wear is reduced. You get a smoother, quieter, more economical ride. Optional at extra cost.

BRAKES: "Duo-servo" type, four-wheel hydraulic brakes. Cable-type parking brake.

TIRES: 7.10 x 15, tires, mounted on pressed steel wheels with wide base rims.

EXTERIOR COLOURS: Black, Sheridan Blue, Forest Green, Palisade Green, Dover Grey, Metallics-Alpine Blue, Bimini Blue, Cambridge Maroon, Maywood Green.






