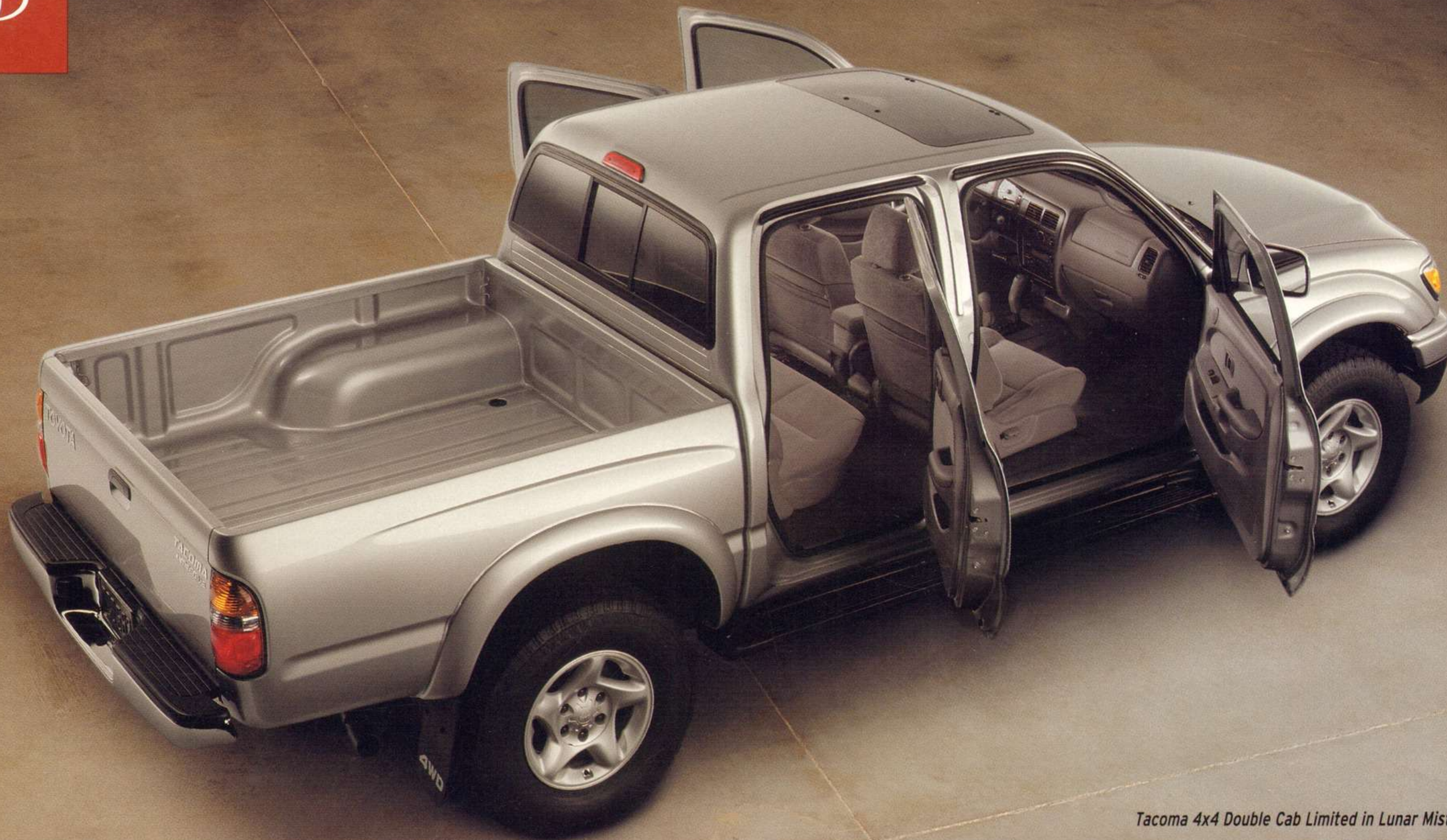

***Double your possibilities with Tacoma Double Cab.***

Tacoma Double Cab is a rugged people mover with four real doors, room inside for five and all the safety features you expect from Toyota. It's also a cargo mover, with ample space

in the five-foot-plus bed, and with a quick flip of the rear seats, inside space for valuable gear. Whatever the need, Tacoma Double Cab easily adapts to meet it.

**Safety Features**

- Side-impact door beams in all four doors
- Driver and passenger air bag\* Supplemental Restraint System (SRS)
- Front seatbelt pretensioners with force limiters
- Child-protector rear door locks
- 4-wheel ABS brake system
- Child seat restraint tethers

\*The Toyota driver and front passenger air bags are a Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) designed to inflate in a severe frontal collision. In all other accidents, seatbelts offer primary protection, and the air bags will not inflate. Do not sit or place objects close to an air bag. To minimize the risk of severe injury or death in all types of crashes, seatbelts must be worn at all times by all vehicle occupants. Do not use a rearward-facing child seat in any front passenger seat. The force of a deploying air bag SRS may cause serious injury or death.
