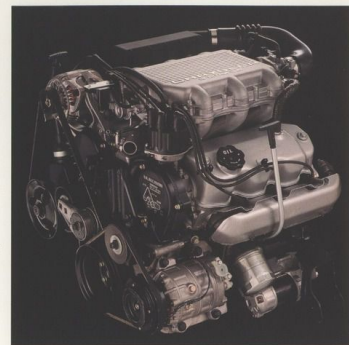


The standard P195/75R14 all-season steel-belted radial white sidewall tires are designed to complement the New Yorker's suspension. (Set of four.)

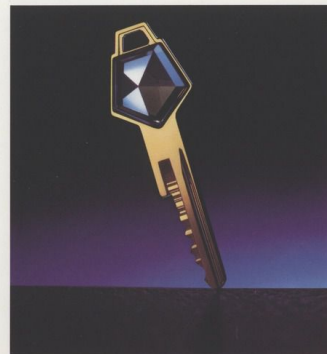

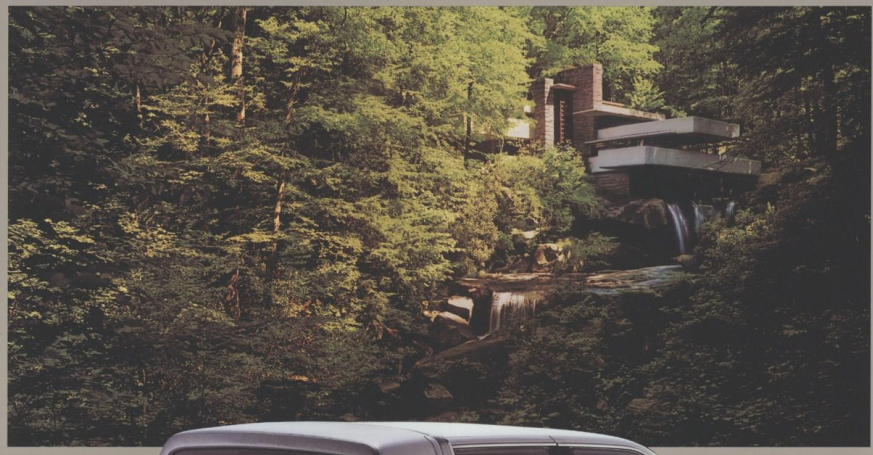

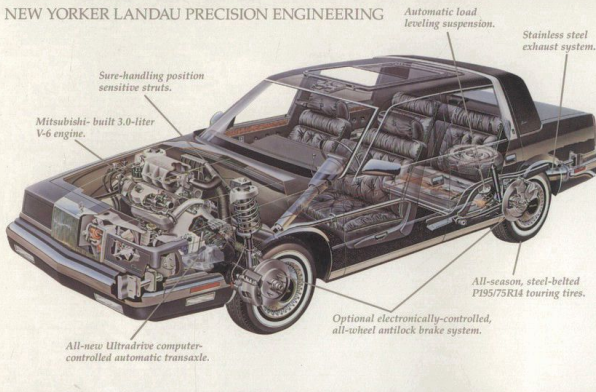

1. Tilt steering column. Adjusts to six positions for ultimate driver comfort. Standard on Landau.*

2. Power sun roof, with sliding sunshade. When sun roof is opened, air deflector rises and roof panel is concealed beneath roof. Extra-cost option on Landau†

3. Power windows and door locks. Power windows are standard. Power door locks, with automatic speed-sensitive actuation and a new feature that prevents doors from locking if key is left in the ignition, are standard on Landau.‡

4. Power adjustable outside mirrors. Both driver and passenger side mirrors are heated for greater safety in foul weather. Standard.
