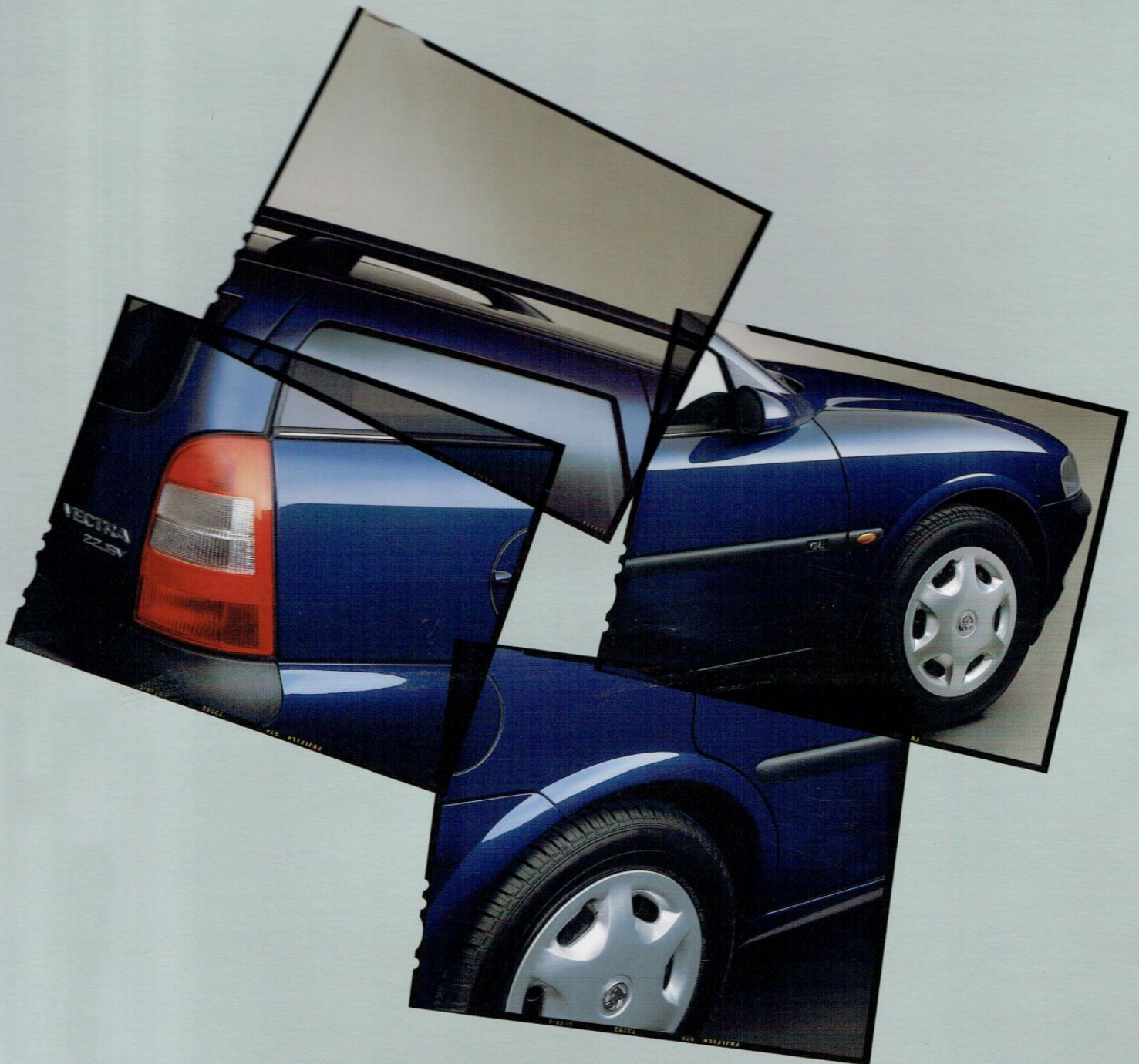

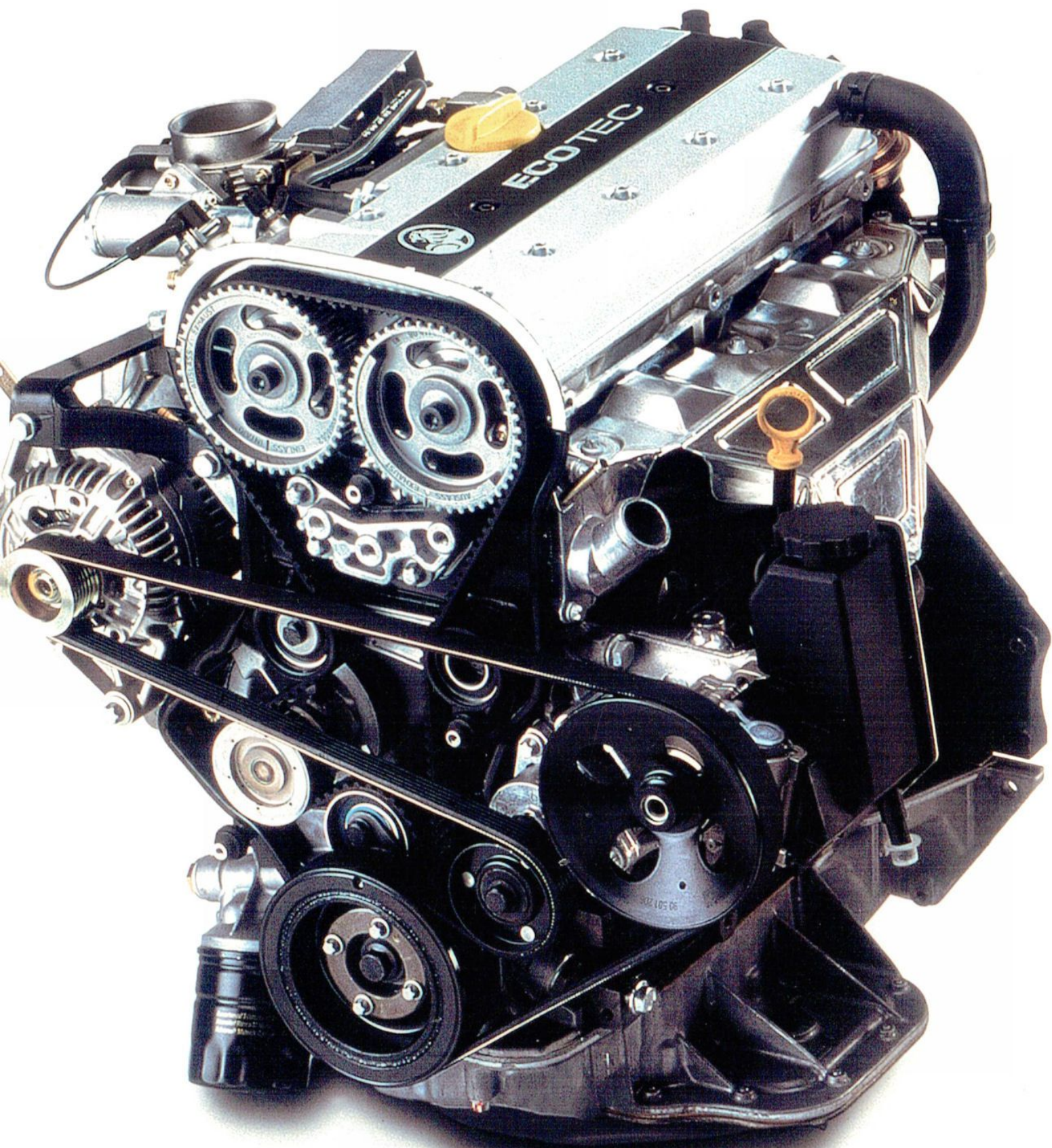

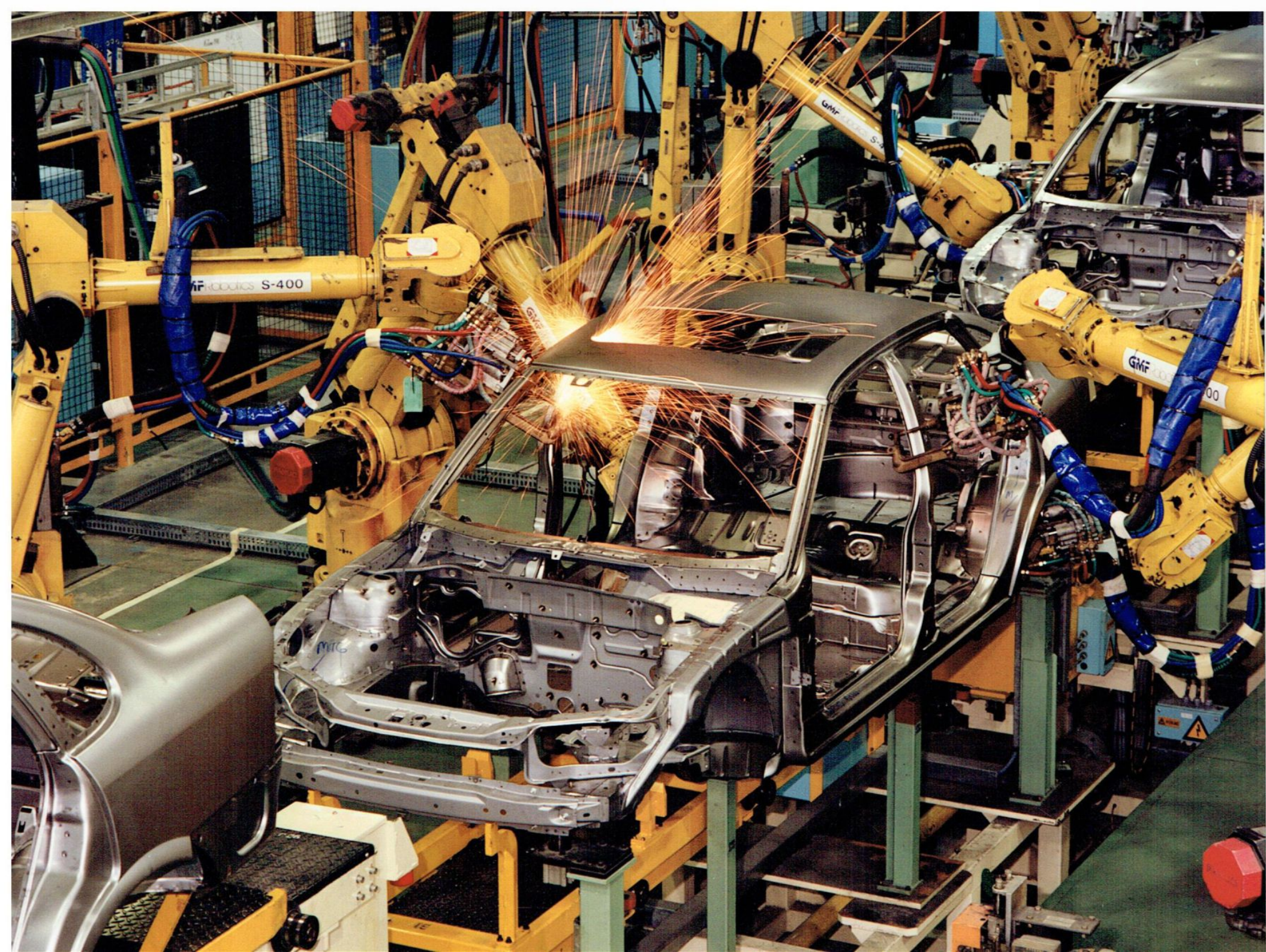




HOLDEN

Vectra's locally built 2.2 litre ECOTEC four cylinder engine has been developed by Holden specifically for Australian conditions. Its longer stroke of 94.6mm produces 104kW of power at 5200rpm and maximum torque of 200Nm at 4000rpm. Twin counter-rotating balance shafts provide for smoother, more efficient engine operation.
