THE STYLISH JS SERIES II HOLDEN VECTRA

Fine-tuned good looks, new Getrag manual transmission

Holden's successful and stylish Vectra range has further benefited from a number of refinements that accentuate its classy good looks and deliver even more responsive performance and handling.

Design elements that distinguish the JS Series II versions of the Holden Vectra sedan, wagon and hatch include a chrome grille surround, new body colour bumpers front and rear, sporty new door sills and jewelled finish headlamps and indicators.

Holden engineers have improved low to mid-range torque availability in the 2.2 litre engine that powers Vectra sedans and wagons, increasing its responsiveness in everyday traffic conditions and overtaking manoeuvres. There is an all-new 5-speed Getrag manual transmission, and suspension refinements further improve Vectra's handling and dynamic safety characteristics.

Holden Director of Sales and Marketing, Ross McKenzie, says the new edition Vectra will build on the success of its award-winning predecessor and take an even larger slice of the medium-size market.

"Just two years after its introduction, Vectra has managed to capture 20 per cent of this category in the face of stiff competition, which is quite an achievement – and testament to a great car. It is encouraging to see Vectra bringing new customers into Holden dealerships.

"The improvements we've made to the Series II Vectra range can only enhance its reputation as a very smart mid-sized choice at superior value for money," Ross McKenzie said.

Style and Practicality

Styling changes to the '99 Vectra serve to highlight its trademark good looks and to emphasise an impression of strength and agility. More than merely decorative, Vectra's halogen, jewelled finish headlamps deliver a 20 per cent increase in light intensity – a contribution to safer driving. Reversing lamps now sport distinctive smoked indicator lenses, and all models are now fitted with a new, rapid-response centre mounted LED technology stop light at the upper edge of the rear window. Designers have extended the surface area on exterior mirrors, enlarging the driver's rear field of vision by 12 per cent, and there's a revised decklid and tailgate locking system. Body coloured door sills and a deeper rear bumper provide a stronger presence and complement the performance orientation of the new Vectra.

All models feature sporty new wheel designs, and sedan and wagon models offer three new colour finishes: Cinnabar (rich, deep orange), Tiger (highly chromatic orange/gold) and Phantom (neutral black with high sparkle). Vectra hatch models also offer three new colours: Star (Silver), Marseille (Red) and Classic (Green).

Interior trims, in subtly-patterned grey tones and specific to each model level, are allnew. Newly sculpted backrests on front seats allow rear seat passengers 30mm of additional
legroom. Ergonomics specialists have revised the centre console instrument layout and
controls. A new **roof console**, located behind the reading lights, provides handy storage for
sunglasses, garage remote controls and other small items. CD models now feature chrome
door handles.

Performance and Handling Further Refined for Australian Conditions

The 2.2 litre 16 valve DOHC that powers Vectra GL sedans and wagons and CD sedans now offers a three per cent increase in low to mid-range torque availability, achieved through the adoption of a specially developed long branch front exhaust pipe and corresponding engine calibration adjustments.

Vectra sedan, wagon and four-cylinder hatch offer an all-new, five speed, close ratio Getrag manual transmission. More refined, quieter and smoother, it features cable-shift, increased torque carrying capacity, synchromesh on reverse gear, hydraulic clutch actuation and revised gear ratios. The benefits include improved acceleration for overtaking in 4th and 5th gears; a sportier driving 'feel'; more precise gear-change; easier selection of reverse gear.

Holden chassis engineers continue to fine-tune Vectra ride and handling characteristics to suit Australian driving conditions. Suspension improvements include stabiliser bar refinements. The changes reduce body roll, improve steering response and improve cornering ability. Power steering refinements, which include a revised hydraulic control valve, deliver better on-centre feel. Drivers and passengers will appreciate the noticeable reduction in road

noise resulting from new bushings in the rear lower control arms together with newly developed tyres on locally manufactured sedans and wagons.


