

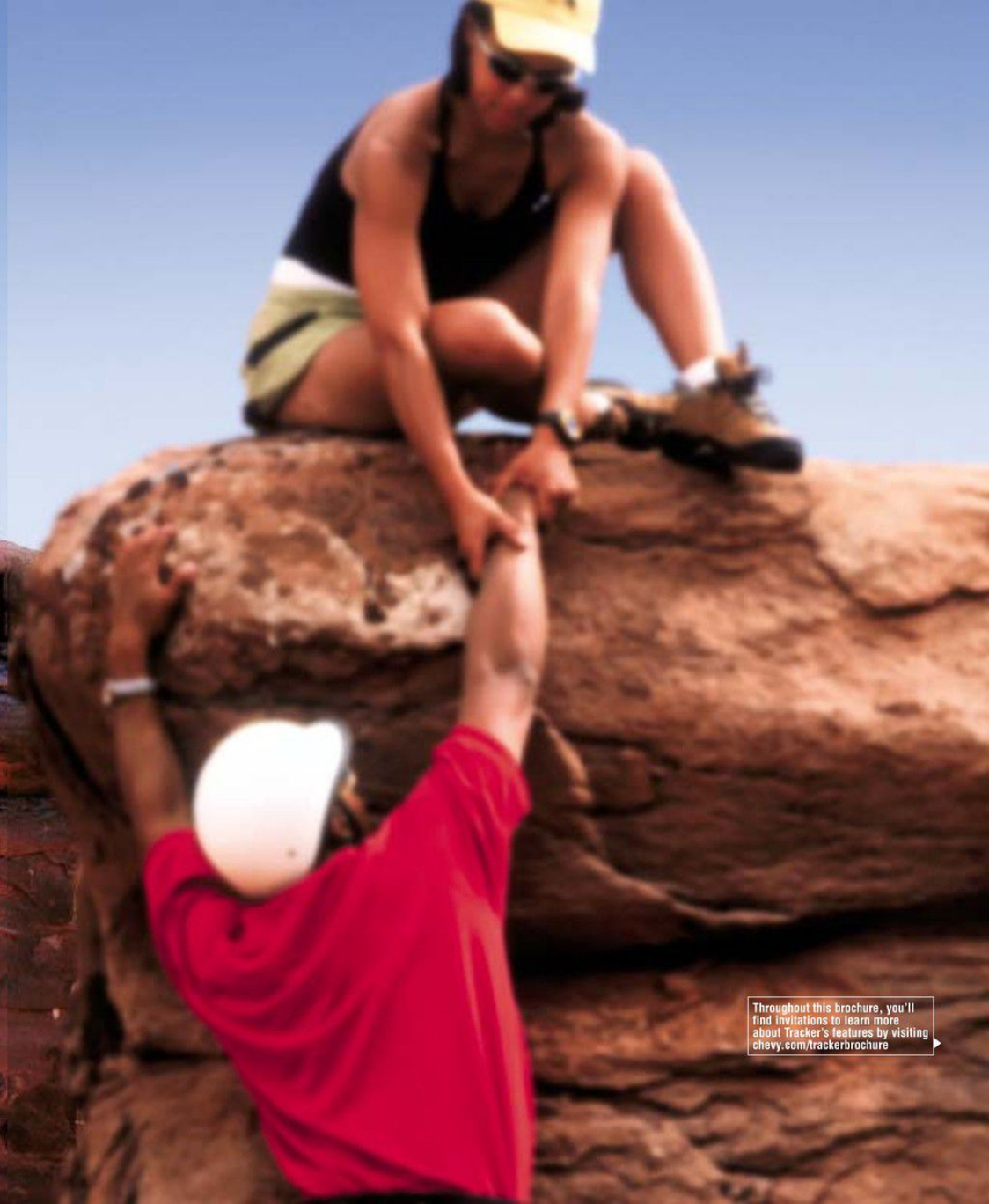

Before heading out for a weekend of adventure, it helps to have the right equipment. That's the same thinking that went into equipping Chevy Tracker Base models. For power, these models feature a four-cylinder engine that has more torque than Kia Sportage. Add to this an MSRP that's thousands less than Honda CR-V* and you'll find that Tracker comes out on top.

*Price comparison based on 2001 MSRP of Tracker Base model 2WD and Honda CR-V LX base model 2WD. Level of equipment varies.

With its 2.0 Liter DOHC 16-valve four-cylinder engine and 17.4-gallon fuel tank (approx.), Tracker 4-Door 2WD models provide a highway driving range of more than 450 miles.*

Tracker is designed and engineered with features that you'll find in other Chevy Truck models — like a steel ladder-type frame, rust-through corrosion protection and available 4x4 capability. They're just part of what makes Tracker a dependable Chevy Truck.

V6 Power

Tracker LT and ZR2 4-Door models come with a standard V6 engine that generates 165 hp at 6500 rpm and 162 lb.-ft. of torque at 4000 rpm.

Anti-Flex Bar

Tracker has an anti-flex bar that arches across its engine compartment to tie the front suspension strut towers together. This helps strengthen the Tracker body structure.

Four-Speed Automatic Transmission

The available four-speed automatic transmission includes a power switch. When selected, automatic transmission upshifts are delayed to help enhance acceleration. It's a handy feature to use when you're merging and passing on the freeway.

Four-Wheel-Drive System

On Tracker 4x4 models, the four-wheel-drive system includes a two-speed transfer case which provides a 4L (four-wheel low) setting. This function enhances traction when you're driving on challenging terrain.

Protective Measures

Tracker features side-door beams, crush zones and an integrated steel protective-cage design around the interior compartment to help keep you and your passengers safe.

Corrosion Protection

The body (except roof) of Chevy Tracker is made of two-sided galvanized steel. It's a process that applies a zinc-alloy coating to both sides of the sheet metal to enhance corrosion resistance. The body is warranted against rust-through for six years or 100,000 miles, whichever comes first.*

Six-Layer Paint Process

A six-layer basecoat/clearcoat paint process is used on Chevy Tracker. The process is designed to keep the exterior paint glossy.

Power Rack-And-Pinion Steering

Tight turning is no problem in Chevy Tracker, thanks to standard power rack-and-pinion steering.

Standard Power Front Disc/Rear Drum Brakes

Power brakes provide dependable stopping capability on Tracker. Ventilated front disc rotors help keep the brake system cool, especially when you're driving in stop-and-go city traffic or on mountain grades.

MacPherson Struts

MacPherson front struts utilize a coil spring that's separate from the shock absorber. This design helps Tracker handle rugged terrain.

Dual Body-Isolation System

This feature provides two layers of suspension/body ride-cushioning materials to help soften harsh vibrations and quiet the ride.

Ladder-Type Frame

Tracker has a rugged, durable steel ladder-type frame that contributes to the vehicle's structural stiffness. This helps make your ride seem smoother, even on rough roads.

Stainless-Steel Exhaust

A stainless-steel exhaust system is designed for years of use. It's just one of the many engineering features that makes Tracker a rugged, dependable Chevy Truck.

Large Fuel Tanks

Tracker 4-Door 2WD models have a 17.4-gallon tank and provide a highway driving range of more than 450 miles between fill-ups.* Tracker 2-Door Convertible models have a 14.8-gallon tank and provide a highway driving range of more than 380 miles.* (NOTE: Fuel tank capacities are approx.)

To get to remote off-road locations, you need the right amount of power. Tracker LT and ZR2 4-Door models have a standard 2.5 Liter 24-valve DOHC V6 engine with 165 hp and 162 lb.-ft. of torque. There's also a hardworking 2.0 Liter four-cylinder engine that is standard in ZR2 2-Door Convertible and Base models. The engine has 127 hp and 134 lb.-ft. of torque. And when you need to tow, Tracker 4-Door models can handle up to 1,500 lbs. (1,000 lbs. for 2-Door models).^{*} With confident power, Chevy Tracker has what it takes.

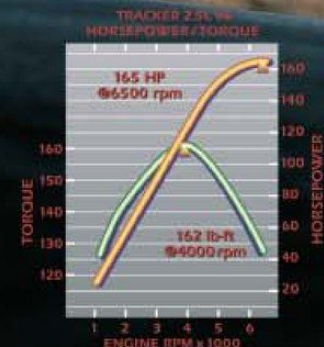

As the official vehicles of the U.S. Snowboard Team, Chevy Trucks includes Tracker as part of its model lineup. And with the extreme weather the team encounters, they can feel confident knowing Tracker is designed to help occupants feel secure. In fact, the 2001 Tracker 4-Door received "★★★★" in a recent front crash test conducted by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) as part of its New Car Assessment Program (NCAP). In addition, Tracker received

positive scores in a number of categories in frontal offset crash testing conducted by the Insurance Institute of Highway Safety (IIHS). Tracker models also include these safety and security features:

- Driver and right front-passenger air bags.*
- Available four-wheel antilock brakes.
- Child security locks on rear side doors.
- Child safety rear-seat top-tether anchors.
- Daytime Running Lamps with Automatic Exterior Lamp Control.

Side-Door Beams

Located inside Chevy Tracker's doors, side-door beams are designed to help reduce intrusion into the passenger compartment in the event of a shallow-angle side impact.



Crush Zones

Crush zones are designed to help absorb the energy of a front or rear impact. They help dissipate impact energy to reduce intrusion into the passenger compartment.

Safety-Cage Construction

As part of Tracker's design, a protective cage has been formed around the passenger compartment. The feature is designed to help reduce injury in the event of a collision.

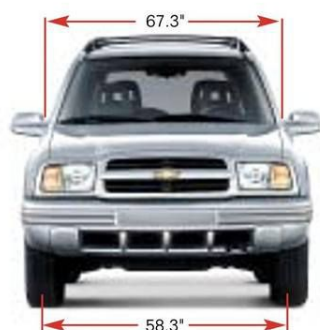
