




From High Intensity Discharge xenon headlights to unique jeweled taillights, from a performance-enhancing gated automatic transmission shifter to motorcycle-inspired gauges, Altima doesn't just stand out as special, it vaults over everything else cluttering the highway.



Looks like Altima's biggest challenge is just standing still. Deep within its psyche lies a driving force of pure aluminum – in the guise of an available 240-hp, 3.5-L V6 powerhouse. And an all-out, high-performance suspension front and rear. Once you drive the new Altima, the symptoms become apparent. Sweaty palms, dry mouth, an itch that only one thing can scratch: taking to the road for another dose of performance.





ALUMINUM Think about those old-time cast-iron skillets. Do you really want to be driving around in that? Altima's aluminum-alloy block is designed for extraordinary strength. Yet the use of lightweight aluminum – in the block, pistons and cylinder heads – ensures an agile free-revving power plant.



LESS FRICTION It's a basic rule of physics: Smooth surfaces slide more easily, allowing an engine to do more with less effort. So we put an ultra-slick coat of molybdenum on Altima's pistons. Then, we microfinished Altima's camshafts and crankshaft, giving them a mirror-smooth finish, which maximizes power delivery, cuts noise and optimizes fuel efficiency.




VARIABLE CAPACITY MUFFLER (4-CYL.)

More exhaust flow means more power. More noise, too. A special muffler valve solves the problem by staying closed at low rpm (less noise) and opening as revs rise (more power). So Altima enters every scene as the strong, silent type.

THE POWER OF AIR Altima's Variable Intake System (shown above) ensures plenty of thrust off the line; then as rpm rise, a shorter air path opens in the manifold, providing a direct pipeline to Altima's class-leading horsepower.* In much the same way, Continuously Variable Timing Control precisely modulates when engine valves open and close using factors like throttle position and engine rpm. Plenty of low-end torque, impressive power as speeds rise.

regular replacement), a timing chain has no standard maintenance. And Altima's timing chain goes a step further: it's designed to be nearly silent. MORE THAN SIMPLY COMING TO A STOP Braking power is easy to take for granted. Hit the pedal and you stop, right? Well, there's a lot more to it than that. Altima has 4-wheel disc brakes standard. Discs offer shorter stopping distances, greater precision and better road-feel versus drum brakes. An available Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) helps you maintain steering control in emergency situations. Think that's enough? We're just getting started. Altima also offers Brake Assist, which helps you reach maximum stopping power easily and rapidly. Finally, Electronic Brake force Distribution (EBD) senses the weight in the rear of the car (trunk, back seat) and sends more force to the rear brakes, if necessary. Now go, and never underestimate the importance of good brakes again. (See Specs chart for availability.)



What sets Altima apart? Simply put, it's a matter of DNA: the passion and imagination deep inside every Nissan engine, every curve of sheet metal, every single weld. It's the way we've always built cars and trucks. And it's why Nissans feel different on your drive. Why they rev eagerly, corner with conviction, brake with assurance. We give you some of the details here; of course, taking the wheel and seeing for yourself is also highly recommended.


WHAT'S BETWEEN YOU AND THE ROAD A suspension cushions the bumps and absorbs the punishment of the pavement. (What a thankless job.) It also makes the difference between sports-car nimble and gooey-as-molasses. So, in designing the totally new 2002 Altima, we borrowed some super car wizardry: a multi-link, fully independent rear suspension derived from the legendary Nissan Skyline. You'll find uncommon handling and responsiveness. You should not be surprised.

SPEED-SENSITIVE STEERING We may not have mastered mind-reading technology yet, but Altima's steering system is the next best thing. It adapts to the driving scenario, giving you more power-assist at low engine speeds. Then it gets tighter – sportier – as revs rise, for that glued-to-the-blacktop feeling.

XENON HEADLIGHTS V6 Altimas are available with cutting-edge High Intensity Discharge xenon headlights. They're 150% as bright as traditional halogen bulbs. And they emit a soft beam that's closer to natural sunlight. Another bright idea from Nissan.








THE FLIP SIDE OF PERFORMANCE: SAFETY When you're behind the wheel, you're probably thinking curves and straightaways. We invite you to consider beams and buckling creases. Welded into all four of Altima's doors are pipe-style steel guard beams, helping to make the cabin the most protected area of the car. Crumple zones front and rear help absorb crash energy. And the hood is designed with buckling creases that help keep it from intruding into the cabin in the event of a crash. You may now return to your dreams of the open road, secure in the thought that Altima is designed to help keep you safe.
