THE 2011 FORD F-550 **SUPER DUTY FIRE TRUCK**

This 2011 Ford F-550 Super Duty XLT chassis cab, upfitted as a fire department firstresponder truck, made its debut at the 2009 L.A. Auto Show. The Ford F-550 was the cornerstone of a program that enabled auto show attendees to aid the Los Angeles County Firefighters Widows and Orphans Fund. Ford donated \$10,000 to the fund at the outset, then \$10 for those who visited the Ford display at the show and \$20 for those who test drove a Ford vehicle at the show. The program raised \$75,000 for the fund.
