An interior view of the Signet showing its dazzling appointments and snappy bucket seats.



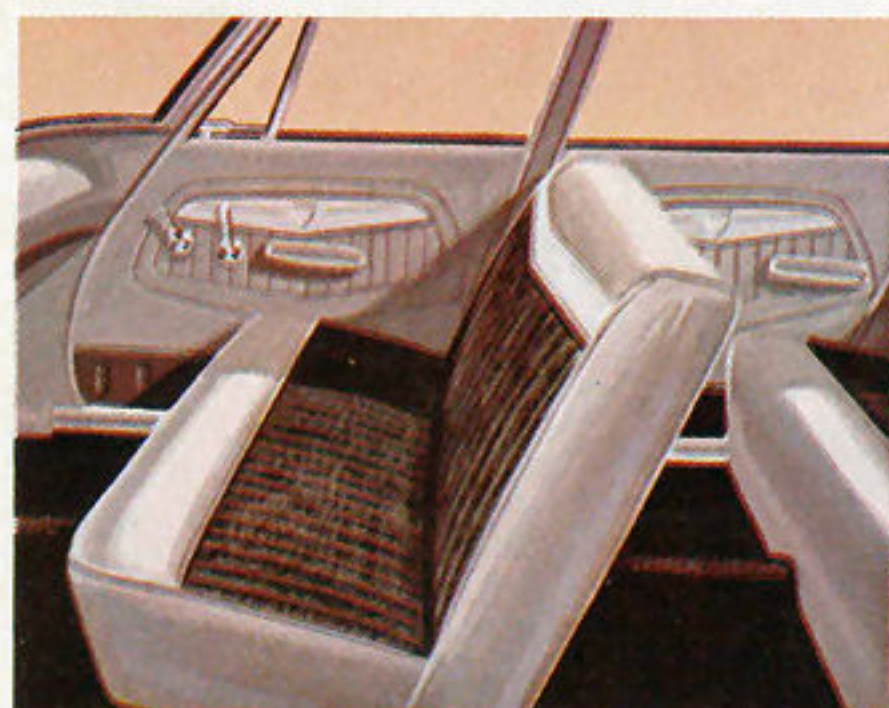

THE MOST BEAUTIFUL AND EFFICIENT INSTRUMENT PANEL IN ANY COMPACT

Instrument dials are specially designed for instant "reading." The speedometer is to the left of the column for easy readability. The three engine instruments—gasoline, temperature, amperes—are lined up to the right. The face of the panel is of precision molded plastic, surfaced in black leather grain effect and outlined by a fine bright ridge. Smart shock-absorbing padding is also available.
