matically. Flick a toggle switch. Scan a panel of non-glare gauges, padded above – and below. Set the trip odometer on zero. Slide into optional shoulder harness. Buckle. 60 seconds are up. Ignition lamp goes off. Automatically. Turn the key. Shift a lever. Toe the throttle. And head for open places. Tune in an optional stereo unit. 8-track tape system or AM/FM Multiplex. With 5 separate speakers (4 with rear window defogger). Turn on optional air conditioning and regulate 300's interior climate with

automatic temperature control. Quietly. Completely. By now, you should be getting somewhere. Somewhere far away. Arrive there in 300. And disturb the peace in quiet. For the Hardtop buff: 300's 2-door version. The 14th edition of this close-cornering, smooth-handling Chrysler. Credit goes where credit's due. To a refined suspension system that combines racing-type, chrome steel torsion bars up front, with leaf springs trailing. Little things mean a lot in the 300. Like 20.8 gallon gas tank

and front seat back safety latches on the buckets, a remote control outside mirror is standard. A few well-chosen handling options can be ordered with any 300. Power-assisted front disc brakes. Sure-Grip differential. Heavy-duty suspension components. Chromed steel road wheels, 3 speed, non-streak electric windshield wipers. In short, the works.





You expect more in the way of options from Chrysler. And you get it. An AM/FM Stereo Multiplex radio with no less than 5 separate speakers surrounds you with music. And if that isn't enough, there's a built-in 8 track stereo tape deck so you can play your kind of music. Continually. Without interruptions.

Between bucket seats, a sporty console for changing gears complete with read-it-at-a-glance performance indicator.

For really gung-ho motoring, a 440 cubic inch TNT engine: 375 rather wild horses, 4 barrel carburetor, dual exhausts, twin snorkels air cleaner, special camshaft.

Just a hint at the safety options: electric door locks—you lock them; they stay locked until you unlock them.

The Automatic Speed Control: you pick the speed you want to travel at. You lift a finger and set the speed. Then

you forget it. Until you want to change it. Then what? Touch the brake and you're in complete command again.

A word about the wheels. Safety rims are standard. They have a double bead to lock tires on in case of failure. But you can dress up the standard wheels with some very un-standard wheel covers. The one shown above is our Deluxe. Very distinctive, very elegant and quite affordable.

Talking of elegance, the bucket seats you see are finished off in genuine leather. Rich, fade-free leather that somehow seems to improve with age. Headrests, too. And an electrically-operated passenger seat that tilts to 7 different reclining positions.

For 1968, Chrysler has options to suit every taste. A full list appears in the Buyer's Guide sections listed with each model. Read it before you make your move.

1968 Chrysler Specifications

A few thousand words for the man who'd like to know why his Chrysler will be worth more if he ever decides to sell it.

Body Construction: All structural steel frame members, body braces, sills, and metal panels that make up the body have been welded into a single unit. There are over 5,000 individual welds in each Unibody. The result is a solid shell of unusual strength—and silence.

Once welded together, all Unibodies are dipped and sprayed 6 times in a series of cleaning, rinsing, and rust-inhibiting chemical baths. A 7th step is immersion in a special corrosion-resistant primer that covers both inside and outside of all lower body sheet metal and structural members.

Brakes: All Chryslers have a dual braking system, one for front wheels, the other for rear wheels. If a hydraulic leak or malfunction should develop in one system, the other serves as a back-up. A warning light on the instrument panel notifies the driver whenever pressure or brake fluid is low in either system.

The parking brake is connected to cables that apply the rear wheel brakes. A warning light notifies drivers when the parking brake is on.

Chrysler brakes are self-adjusting whenever they are applied while transmission is in reverse. Chrysler brakes are also the largest standard brakes in the low or medium price class. Effective lining area is 223.4 sq. in. for Newports and Newport Customs, 234.1 sq. in. for all other models. Optional front disc brakes are available on all Chryslers. Total swept area is 437.1 square inches.

Cleaner Air System: This system of engine exhaust emission control provides for a more complete burning of the fuel-air mixture in combustion chambers, and consequently a reduction of unburned hydro-carbons and carbon monoxide concentrated in the exhaust system. The Cleaner Air System consists primarily of: a slightly altered distributor, to retard spark at idle; a modified carburetor for

lean fuel/air mixture at part throttle; and other modifications to the combustion chamber design, induction system and exhaust system.

Cooling System: Chrysler's radiator and block, including heater, have a 14.2 quart coolant capacity (14.7 quart with 440 engine). A thermostatic by-pass control and pressure vent radiator cap regulate temperatures automatically.

Electrical System: Chrysler's 12-volt battery is rated at 59-ampere-hours. (70-ampere-hours with 440 engine). Alternator is rated at 37 ampere. Electric windshield wipers are standard. 2-speeds on Newport, Newport Custom, 300. 3-speeds on Town & Country and New Yorker.

Engines: Chrysler's standard and optional engines are advanced-design, overhead valve V-8s. Combustion chambers are wedge-shaped for efficient fuel burning. Pistons are lightweight aluminum, with steel struts for heat expansion control. Connecting rods and crankshaft are of forged steel. Tappets are operated hydraulically. Exhaust valves of hardened steel-alloy are heat resistant, and rotate to equalize wear and extend valve life. Cleaner Air System reduces air pollution, keeps vital engine parts cleaner.

Mufflers and tailpipes on all engines are aluminized to resist corrosion. (See engine chart below.)

Fuel System: Fuel flow is governed by an automatic choke and manual fuel pump on all Chryslers. Tank capacity is 18.3 gallons on Town & Country models, 20.8 on all other Chryslers.

There are two fuel filters. A woven plastic 40-micron filter in the gasoline tank, and a replaceable 15-micron paper filter in the fuel line between fuel pump and carburetor.

The TorqueFlite automatic 3-speed transmission is standard on all models. TorqueFlite's torque converter is water-cooled. It combines with a balanced 3-speed gear assembly to provide continued smooth and economical shifting. Special transmission oil, installed at the

factory, stays thin at low temperatures to provide easier cold-weather starting and smoother operation.

Suspension and Handling: Torsion-Aire suspension consists of 2 chrome-steel torsion bars up front, and leaf springs in the rear. The result is a level and responsive ride in all driving maneuvers.

A sway bar in front helps body resist lean. Diagonally-mounted steel struts reinforce the front wheel lower control arms. These arms are slightly angled to prevent front-end "dip" during hard braking. Shock absorbers are hydraulic, double-action type.

There are 5½ rear cushion leaf springs in each rear spring assembly on Newports and Newport Customs, 6½ on all other models.

For heavier loads, a trailer-towing package is available as an option and permits towing up to 5,500 pounds. A load-equalizing hitch with TorqueFlite trans. is required.

The components provided in the trailer towing package are: • Maximum Capacity Cooling System, with high capacity radiator and larger trans. oil cooler, 7 blade fan, fan shroud, and yoke-to-hood air seal.

Here's how Chrysler's Customer Care Warranty protects you: Chrysler Canada Ltd. warrants against defects in materials and workmanship and will repair or replace without charge for parts or labour at a Chrysler Canada Ltd. authorized dealer's place of business, the engine block, head and all internal engine parts, intake manifold, water pump, transmission case and all internal transmission parts, torque converter (if so equipped), drive shaft, universal joints, rear axle and differential, suspension system (except shock absorbers), steering gear and linkage system, wheels and wheel bearings of its 1968 Chrysler-built automobiles for 5 years or 50,000 miles and all other parts for 24 months or 24,000 miles, whichever occurs first, excluding only tires, normal maintenance replacement of spark plugs, condensers, ignition points, filters, brake and clutch lining, etc., and normal deterioration of hoses, belts, upholstery, soft trim and appearance items. Maintenance services required under the warranty are: change engine oil every 3 months or 4,000 miles, whichever occurs first, and replace oil filter every second oil change, clean carburetor air filter every 6 months and replace every 2 years, lubricate front suspension ball joints and tie rod ends at 3 years, or 36,000 miles, whichever occurs first; check operation of crankcase ventilator valve and clean oil filter cap every 6 months and replace the ventilator valve every year; and every 12 months have a Plymouth or Dodge dealer certify (i) receipt of evidence of performance of the required services and (ii) the car's then current mileage.
